<p>Elder Keith Fought preached "My God is Huge and My God is Able. If I Don't Get What I Ask For, He Will Give Me Something Bigger" using Psalm 37: 3-5. Trust in the Lord and do good. Trust Him when you're troubled; trust Him when you're down in the valley, Family, friends and coworkers may fail you but God never will. He has promised that He will never leave or forsake us. God can take the impossible and make it possible if you trust Him. No matter how strong or smart you are, you are nothing without God. When you trust Him everything is going to be fine. My God is huge and able to do all things. God still works miracle. He's alive and well!</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph preached "The Third Firmament" using Ezekiel 1:22-23. A firmament is an expanse. The first firmament (or first heaven) is the sky where birds fly. The second firmament (or second heaven) is outer space where stars and planets are found. The third firmament (or third heaven) is the home of God in eternity, or the place of the nearness of His presence. The presence of God can be understood spiritually and physically. When we are in the presence of God spiritually we are with Him, yet not physically. When we get to see Jesus face to face, we will be there physically. The third firmament (as in Ezekiel 1:22) is beneath the very throne of God, and above the mighty cherubim (Ezekiel 1:23) who in Scripture seem to indicate the near presence of God. This third firmament is glorious, brilliantly crystalline in appearance. It must be the third heaven to which the apostle Paul was once caught up in a special manifestation of God's presence and power, to hear "unspeakable words" from God in "paradise" (II Cor. 12:2-4). All three firmaments "declare the glory of God" and show "his handiwork" (Psalm 19:1). Therefore, we should "praise God in his sanctuary" and also "praise him in the firmament of his power" (Psalm 150:1).</p>	<p>Elder David Harris preached "Here Comes My Help" using Psalm 120:1 &amp; 121:1-2. In our distress and troubled times all we have to do is call upon God and He hears us. Our help comes from God. He is our keeper. God will help us in both small and great things. He will supply every need we have. Be stable and steadfast. God is going to do great things for us. Pray and God will be your help. When Jesus was transfigured He was changed. We need to find us a mountaintop and pray. God will meet with us there. People will see a difference in us. (Isaiah 60:1) We need to arise and shine. We need to let our light shine through the darkness of this world so people will see God in us.</p>

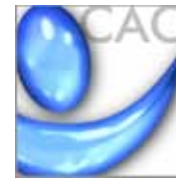
