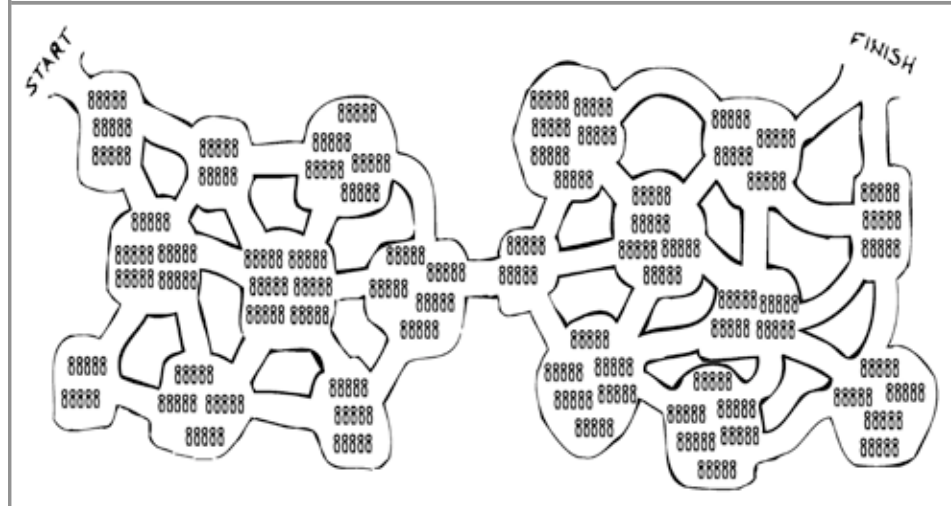

At our Fifth Sunday Celebration	Wednesday
<p>Pastor Joseph preached “God at Work” using John 5: 14-17. Work is not an evil thing, and was not a result of the curse. God was always a “working” God, and man was charged with a work to do in the Garden in Eden even before the sin and the curse. Their sin and the resulting curse added sweat and pain to the work, but the work itself is not intrinsic in the curse. After six days, God had completed His work of Creation, and He would have never had to work on it again (the rest, or cessation, could have been permanent) except for mankind's choice to sin. We messed it up, and God had to go back to work on Creation again, including some work that He could only accomplish as a man. Thus, we can understand the words of Jesus in John 5 as He rebuked the Pharisees after they rebuked Him for working on the Sabbath (healing a man). “Jesus said to them, ‘My Father is always at his work to this very day, and I, too, am working.’” (John 5:17). It was because of human sin that God “is always at His work to this very day.” Jesus went on to show portions of the work that are assigned to His humanity: Of course there is Calvary, which totally completed certain aspects of the work (thus His words, “It is finished”), as pertains to paying for our redemption and salvation, but God still intends more work (besides that) to be the duty of the humanity: Life (resurrection) and final judgment are both done through the Son.</p>	<p>Our guest speaker, Rev. David Hall, pastor of the Apostolic Church of the Tri-State (ACTS) in Barboursville, WV, preached “The Four Hallelujahs” using Revelation 19:1-8 as his text. This very encouraging passage foretells four precious hallelujahs; four specific instances in the future when an innumerable company of redeemed saints will shout praise unto our great God and Savior, Jesus Christ, unto whom belong salvation and glory and power. Often times down here, people question the judgments of the Lord, ignorantly accusing Him of being harsh or uncaring. When we finally get over there, our perspective will affirm to us that indeed “true and just are his judgments.” Sometimes down here we feel like we are but few in number, but in that day all the saints from all the ages will be gathered together, comprising a mighty host of millions upon millions. Our shout of praise unto the Lord will be thundered in a mighty chorus from the lips of blood washed and righteous saints, who collectively make up the Lord’s bride. We will say “Hallelujah! For our Lord God Almighty reigns. Let us rejoice and be glad and give Him glory! For the wedding of the Lamb has come, and His bride has made herself ready.” At that time fine linen, bright and clean, will be given to us to wear. The fine linen will be a symbol that “stands for the righteous acts of the saints.”</p>
