<p>Elder Keith Fought preached “Four More Yards” using Micah 7:8 & II Tim. 4:6-8. Hold onto the faith! Hold onto what God has given you! Never give up; just keep running. Be determined that you’re going to make it no matter what the cost is.</p>	<p>The Lord moved powerfully in this service, and Jesus was the preacher.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph and his mother both attended a workshop on Wed. morning in which they learned why a revocable living trust is vastly superior to a legal will. During the Wed. evening service, Pastor Joseph explained the matter to the church. Not all attorneys know about estate planning. Only a small percentage of lawyers know how to write a trust. Without one, your estate <i>will</i> go before the court if you die. WV state law decrees that any and all assets owned by the deceased must go before the court in a probate process that is both slow and fraught with fees. There are court costs, attorney fees (ranging from 4% to 10% of the total value of the estate), and appraisal fees, just to name a few. Furthermore, once an estate goes before a court, the judge is empowered to actually change the will of the deceased or even throw it out and start from scratch. About one-third of the time, judges do change the will of the deceased in some way. Also, when issues of oversight and guardianship are left up to the courts, often the appointments made are the least beneficial as far as anyone except attorneys are concerned. (Some attorneys are friends with judges, so the courts are prone to award oversight and guardianship—and thus the resulting exorbitant fee income as well—to those friends instead of to loving relatives of surviving family members.)</p>

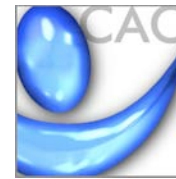
