



If we have the Holy Ghost, there is revival, healing, and victory inside us. God's glory is within us. It's time to get on the winning side. We have the same Spirit within us that raised Christ from the dead. We must cast down every imagination and every high thing that exalteth itself against the knowledge of God, and bring our every thought into captivity to the obedience of God. We have the power to choose what is right or what is wrong. If we don't stand strong the devil will build strongholds in us, but we have power in the Holy Ghost to tear them down. We have victory through our Lord Jesus Christ.</p>	<p>Pastor Joseph taught using I Corinthians 11:1-16. God is the head of Christ, and Christ is the head of every man. Although all men and women are equal spiritually, in marriage and in family life God has placed the man in authority and He expects much from men. A man ought not think of himself too highly. His authority must be in servant leadership. He should serve his wife and love her in the way Christ loves the church. Men are to not let their grow, as a symbol of the unveiled glory of God. Women are to let their hair grow, as a symbol of their submission to godly authority. Nature even teaches us that it is a shame for a man to let his hair grow. A woman who obeys the Bible's teaching on hair should have power on her head because of the angels. v.15: Her hair (Greek: <i>kome</i>, meaning uncut hair) is given to her for a covering.</p>

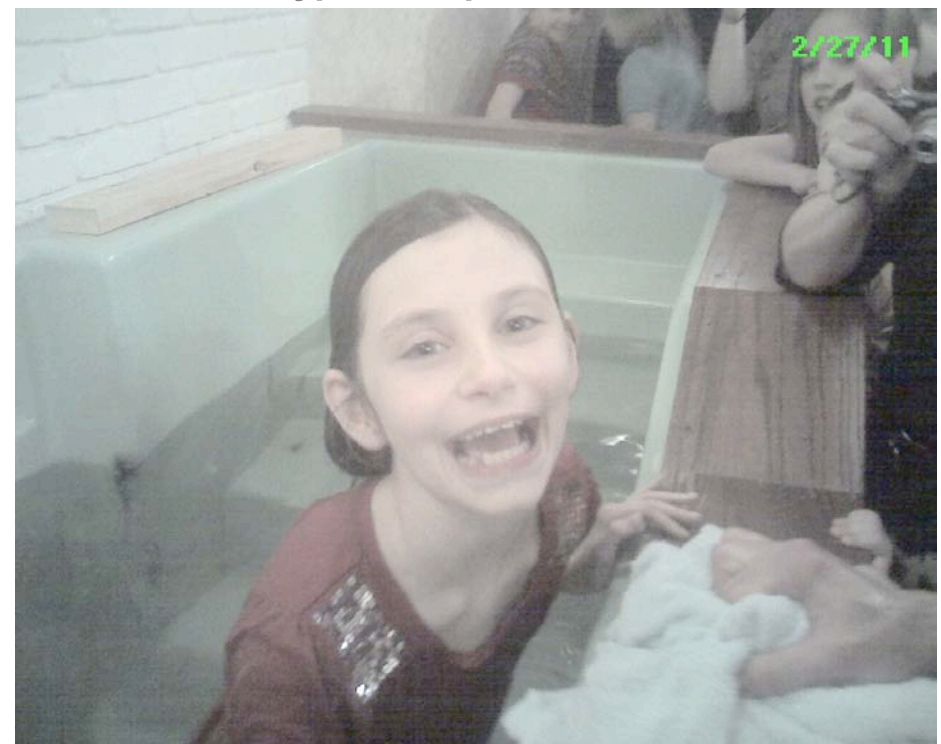
