Tribute: 10th Anniversary of Sept. 11, 2001 ~ Never Forget!



Bridges Closed ~ 9:21 am:

All bridges and tunnels into Manhattan are closed. Residents and workers in lower Manhattan take to the streets to get away from the ash filling the air.

Pentagon Hit ~ 9:40 am:

American Airlines Flight 77 crashes into the west side of the Pentagon, killing all 64 people on board and 125 Pentagon personnel.

White House Evacuated ~ 9:43 am:

The West Wing of the White House and the U.S. Capitol building are evacuated and closed.

South Tower Collapses ~ 9:59 am:

The South Tower of the World Trade Center collapses.

United 93 Crashes ~ 10:03 am:

United Airlines Flight 93 crashes near Shanksville, Pa., following a passenger revolt against the hijackers. All 44 people on board, including 4 hijackers, were killed.

North Tower Collapses ~ 10:28 am:

The North Tower collapses approximately 30 minutes after the South Tower.

Mayor Orders Evac. ~ 10:49 am:

New York City Mayor Rudy Giuliani orders an evacuation of Lower Manhattan.

Firemen Raise the Flag ~ 5:00 pm:

As rescue workers continue to go through the rubble, New York City firemen hoist an American flag at the site of the World Trade Center — an iconic image often compared to the World War II photo of the raising of the flag on the island of Iwo Jima in the Pacific.

Bush Speaks ~ 8:30 pm:

President Bush addresses the nation from the White House. Members of Congress are told that the administration has enough evidence indicating Usama bin Laden and his Al Qaeda terrorist network are responsible for the attacks.

Our nation turned to God in prayer as we mourned 2,819 wrongful deaths.

May God continue to bless America, and may America continue to bless God!

Last Sunday AM

Associate Pastor David Harris Jr preached “This is That!” while showing scriptural, doctrinal, and experiential connections between our modern day church and “old time Pentecost” in the last century, as well as to the first century church in the Book of Acts, he also stressed that personally having the baptism of the Holy Ghost will help one to make right decisions when facing life’s tough challenges. He showed how the Apostle Peter declared that “THIS” (the outpouring of the Spirit in Acts 2, which was prophesied by Jesus in Acts 1) is the fulfillment of “THAT” which was prophesied by the Prophet Joel. He took Isaac, wood, fire, and the knife (but no lamb), to the appointed mountain, telling his young men that he and the lad would go yonder and worship, and then return. He stated this because he had faith that God could even raise Isaac from the dead if need be. Isaac asked where the lamb was. Abraham answered by faith, “God will provide himself a sacrifice.” Isaac submitted because he implicitly trusted both his earthly father, Abraham, and his Heavenly Father, the Lord. God saw Abraham’s faith, and stopped him from doing harm to the lad. Just as they trusted their Heavenly Father, so also we can too. God will provide! We are so glad that Brother Null felt led to revisit CAC at this certain time. We mutually felt led to have him stay through this weekend. We’re glad he is here!

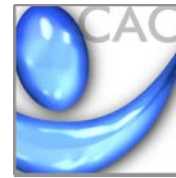

Tribute: 10th Anniversary of Sept. 11, 2001~ Never Forget!

On September 11, 2001, a Muslim terrorist group known as Al Qaeda launched a series of coordinated, deadly terror attacks on American soil that struck the heart of the country's military and financial power centers.

North Tower Hit ~ 8:45 am:

American Airlines Flight 11 crashes into the North World Trade Center tower. Flight 11 departed Boston bound for Los Angeles at 7:59 a.m., carrying 92 people including 5 hijackers.

South Tower Hit ~ 9:03 am:

United Airlines Flight 175 crashes into the South World Trade Center tower. Flight 175 departed Boston bound for Los Angeles carrying 65 people including 5 hijackers.

President Bush Informed ~ 9:05 am:

President George W. Bush, speaking to students at the Emma E. Booker Elementary School in Sarasota, Fla., is interrupted by Chief of Staff Andrew Card about a second plane crashing into the South Tower.

Fighter Jets Deployed ~ 9:13 am:

Two F-15 fighter jets from Otis Air National Guard Base leave military airspace on Cape Cod and head for Manhattan. Minutes later, the Federal Aviation Administration bans takeoffs nationwide for flights to the New York area.
