CAC's Former Pastor, Rev. Terry Null, ministered powerfully. He preached a message from the Lord entitled, "The Prison of Denial" using II Sam 12:1 and Galatians 5:7 as his texts. King David, although he was a man after God's own heart, once fell into a backslidden state in which he committed adultery by fornication, and orchestrated murder. He was so imprisoned in denial that God had to send the Prophet Nathan to boldly and blatantly tell the king of his sin, to break him free from the grip of his sin. Living in the prison of denial is the spiritual equivalent of looking at yourself in those weird mirrors in a carnival's house of mirrors. One who is caught up in this spirit will inwardly deny his sin, while faking outwardly that all is well. Thank God that He loves us enough to send us a man of God to admonish us when we need help in breaking free from the grip of denial & self deception. It's so easy for our carnal nature to convince us that no one knows the truth, but as Psalm 139:3 shows, God knows the truth better than our own hearts can know! The Apostle Paul wrote a letter of stern warning to the churches in Galatia, asking them who had bewitched them. Paul said to the Galatians, "Ye did run well, but who hindered you?" With God's help, anyone can escape from the prison of denial. Let the house of false mirrors be shattered in Jesus name! Be free!

CAC's Former Pastor, Rev. Terry Null, again ministered powerfully. The main emphasis of the Holy Ghost through the ministry of the Word was that there is nothing too hard for God! Brother Null used Jeremiah 32:26-27 for his text. The Lord delivered a powerful prophetic word to Jeremiah, but before He did so, He took time to remind Jeremiah of who He is, saying, "Behold I am the Lord, the God of all flesh." There is nothing too hard for God! There was a powerful anointing of the Lord present for healing, and many were touched. We thank God for using Brother Null to minister to us for the past few services.

Wednesday

Pastor Joseph preached and taught on "True Repentance" using Jonah 3:10 as his main text. True repentance must always be more than just words. It must come from the heart, and it must be backed up with action. God sent the Prophet Jonah to tell the wicked people of Nineveh (the capital city of the Assyrian empire) that they would be destroyed within 40 days. The prophet foresaw that the Assyrians in the city would truly repent, and that God would turn away his fierce anger and judgment. In the prophet's carnal dislike of the Ninevites, he decided he did not want them to be spared. His "racist" goal was for the unrighteous to perish. We must ever be heartbroken when God's judgment on sinners is not avoided. After serving as fish food, Jonah finally obeyed. The Ninevites repented. "And God saw their works that they turned from their evil way and God repented of the evil that He had said He would do unto them; and He did it not" (Jonah 3:10).

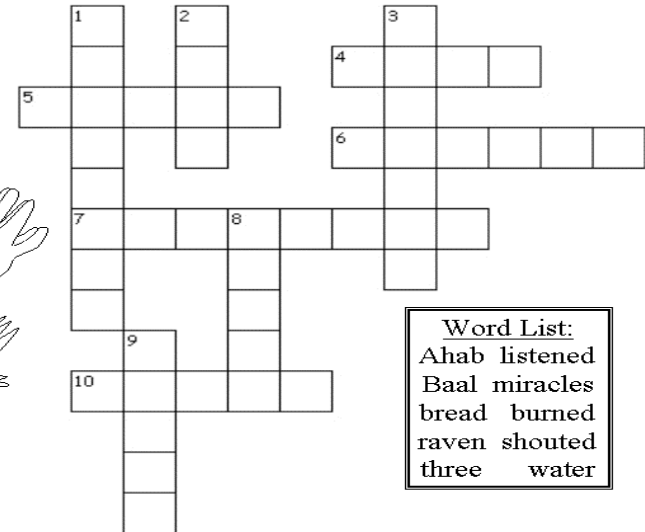
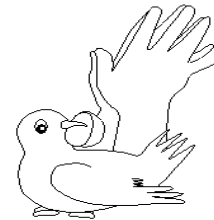

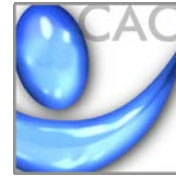
