Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached on the New Birth, using Joel 2:21-32 as his text. The prophet Joel foretold the Holy Ghost outpouring some 500+ years before the Church Age. The fulfillment of Joel's prophecy began on the Feast of Pentecost, (see Acts 2). The foundation of Christianity is the New Testament Gospel message of Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection. These three crucial events lead us to three essential steps of obedient faith: repentance (turning away from sin and turning to God), water baptism in the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, and receiving the baptism of the Holy Ghost (with the evidence of speaking in other tongues). This is how we become identified with Jesus' death, burial, and resurrection. This is the New Birth spoken of in the Gospel of John 3:3-5.

Last Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "When All Heaven Breaks Loose" using several passages: Genesis 37:31-36; Exodus 40:34-38; Numbers 9:15-16; and 11:1-4. The spiritual battle for our soul is fought in the mind. People are often too quick to believe the report of the enemy and often too slow to believe the report of the Lord. Jacob's sons never told their father that their brother, Joseph, was dead. They simply presented false evidence *implying* that he was dead, and Jacob decided that 'without doubt' his son was dead. When the report that is presented to us is false, it leads us toward doubt against what God has spoken. Sometimes doubters will cause us to be swayed away from what God has promised us, as in the case of the ten doubting spies who returned from Canaan land and claimed that they looked like grasshoppers in their own eyes—and therefore also (so they said) like grasshoppers in the eyes of the enemy. We've had enough of "all hell breaking loose" in our lives. Now it's high time for "all Heaven" to break loose! Let's believe the report of the Lord. We are well able to possess the land!

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught about the biblical doctrine of the First Resurrection, using Revelation chapter 20, Matthew 27:50-54, and John 5:19-29 for his texts. Jesus spoke of two different resurrections in John 5:19-29. The Apostle Paul wrote that "Christ is risen from the dead, and has become the firstfruits of those who have fallen asleep" (I Corinthians 15:20). The Scriptures reveal at least three installments in what is called the "First Resurrection." In Matthew 27:50-54, Old Testament saints were resurrected after Jesus' resurrection. That seems to be a first installment. Many scriptures reveal that the Church Age saints will be raised as a second installment. Revelation 20:4-6 describes the final installment, when martyred Tribulation saints will be raised. Only the saved have any part in the First Resurrection. The second, or General Resurrection, comes after the Millennial Kingdom Age. In it, *all* the remaining dead are raised to be judged. Some will be raised unto eternal life (such as those saved during the Millennial Kingdom Age and who died before the end of it) and others unto damnation.

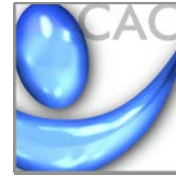

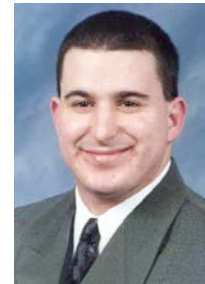
