Associate Pastor David Harris Jr preached "How Close Are We Walking to the Gate?" He used Isaiah 45:2-3 and Palms 107:15-21 for his texts. Jesus described our experience of being born again, as passing through a narrow gate. The gate is the point where the world ends and the Kingdom of God begins. It ought to be the point at which the world's influence over us ends, and a place that we move onward away from. It should not be a place that we camp close to, trying to continue to hear the influence of the word. How close do we want to walk to the gate (world)? After we are born again, we should ask God to bring us out of it, and away from it. We should ask this as often as is needed. Because if we would only stay close to God we would not have to worry about Him needing to break the gates for us. He promised in Isaiah 45:2-3: "I will go before thee, and make the crooked places straight: I will break in pieces the gates of brass, and cut in sunder the bars of iron: And I will give thee the treasures of darkness, and hidden riches of secret places, that thou mayest know that I, the LORD, which call thee by thy name, am the God of Israel." Palms 107:15-21 says, "Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men! For he hath broken the gates of brass, and cut the bars of iron in sunder. Fools because of their transgression, and because of their iniquities, are afflicted. Their soul abhorreth all manner of meat; and they draw near unto the gates of death. Then they cry unto the LORD in their trouble, and he saveth them out of their distresses. He sent his word, and healed them, and delivered them from their destructions. Oh that men would praise the LORD for his goodness, and for his wonderful works to the children of men!"

Elder Keith Fought preached "One Body" using I Corinthians 12:12-31, and Psalms 133 for his texts. 

Christmas Word Scramble


