Last Sunday AM (Pastor and Sis Joseph away in Israel)

Elder Lorren Godwin ministered about the power of a direct relationship with God, using Genesis 12:8 for his text. Many people passed through Bethel during this period, but it wasn't until Jacob was returning to his father's house, as he passed through Bethel, that he had an encounter with God. After his encounter with God, he changed the name to El Bethel, which means the God of the house of God. Until this point, God was just a figure in a story being told. He was someone that his father knew, but he really didn't know Him. God was a mythical being to him, foreign and unknown. But that all changed when he encountered the true God. God now became personal to him. Jacob was totally transformed after his face to face encounter with God. Church attendance alone doesn't change you, but a relationship—a face to face encounter with God—will transform us. It doesn't matter who you are, or what you've been through; after you establish a relationship with God, you cannot be unchanged.

Associate Pastor David Harris Jr preached on praise and worship, under the title of "Bring Hither the Ephod (Won't We Have a Time)." He used Hosea 3:4-5, I Samuel 23:9-12, I Samuel 30:6-8, and John 4:22-24 as his texts. No matter what happens in our life, we just need to get the ephod of worship, and then God will bring victory and give the answers we need. Praise invokes God's help, because it displays openly for all to see, that we do not propose to have all the answers, but that we are actively, deliberately, and with exuberant faith, looking to God for our answers!

Rev. Rusty Sandy preached "Come to Jesus." We can come to Jesus for whatever we need. He does miracles, signs, and wonders! No matter what we need we can go to Jesus! We face trials and tests in our lives, just as Peter was scared of the wind that began to blow. But Jesus is right there, and He will catch us if we fall. The Lord's arm is never short! Have faith that God is always right there to meet your every need. All you have to do is come to Jesus! He has your need or miracle already met. He always will take care of us. No matter what you have done, you can come to Jesus and He will do a work in you.

Rev. Hannah Sandy preached "To Rejoice in Sacrifice." She used Acts 5:39-42 and Matthew 5:10-12. for her texts. Simply scratching the surface of a relationship with God is not enough—if we plan to make a difference not only in our own lives, but in the world. We must choose to follow God and draw closer to Him, even if that means we must suffer and struggle. Since this world is only temporary, we must be like the Apostles, and rejoice that we know Jesus Christ and be glad that we are counted as worthy to suffer for His name. Living comfortably should not be an option for a true believer in Christ; our flesh wants to be comfortable, but what is good for the flesh can be terrible for our walk with God. Only through sacrifice can we do the works of God, anointing does not come without a price. The price is worth it though, because through our sufferings we are able to help add to the church and draw closer to Him.

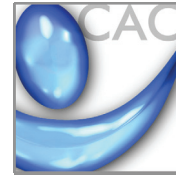
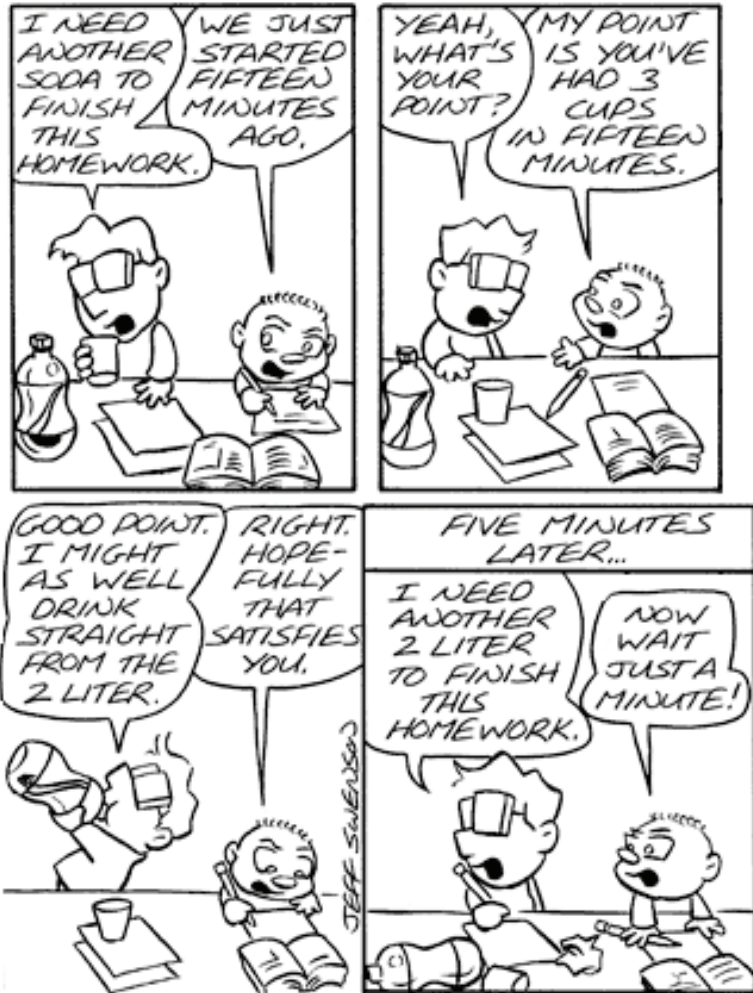
