Associate Pastor David Harris preached "We Must Believe" in support of believing, accepting, and obeying what God communicates to us through His Word, His Spirit, and via the men of God and women of God that He has placed in our life. Elder Harris used various passages of text, including John 14:1-13, Mark 16:15-18, Matthew 9:23-29, Mark 9:23-24, Mark 11:24. "Believe" has been defined as "accept as true; take to be true." There is a certain degree of careful submission required in following the Lord and relating properly to the godly authority of the church's God-appointed leadership. It is important not to rebel against those who are in authority over us. The Lord promised to those who believe that He will show Himself strong on their behalf, that whatsoever they ask in His name, He will do. In Mark 16, the Lord declared that miraculous signs would follow them that believe.

Evangelist Brian Norman preached "When the House of God Becomes Dreadful" using Genesis 28:16-17. We love the house of God. We love the church. We love the people, the blessings, the preaching and doctrine. We have nothing bad to say about the church. So what is the only thing that can make the house of God become dreadful? Jacob came to a place known as Bethel ("House of God"). There he fell asleep, and he dreamed of a "ladder" or stairway to Heaven, with angels ascending and descending. He awoke and realized that God had moved while he was asleep. He lamented that he had slept through the move of God. He renamed the place "El Bethel" ("God of the House of God") and he remarked that "surely the Lord is in this place, and I knew it not." In this passage of scripture, Jacob describes the place as dreadful. So what is the only thing that can make the house of God become dreadful? To sleep through the move of God, and miss His presence, anointing, and help.

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph preached "Don't Doubt God's Heart" using Genesis 3:1-7 and Jeremiah 29:11-14. The Lord gave Adam and Eve a complete paradise in the Garden of Eden, and they had innocence and immortality in a perfect relationship with each other and with God. The scripture says that the serpent, the most subtle of all the beasts of the field, had a conversation with Eve in which she became tricked into doubting God's heart. She inwardly doubted God's intentions and whether God had her best interests in view. This paved the way for her sin of eating of the tree that God had commanded to be left off limits. This leads to an essential truth of scripture: Inward doubt leads to outward sin. Inward faith leads to outward miracles. Have faith in God's heart. Trust that He has your best interest in view. At the core of any sin is an essential distrust of God's intentions, which paves the way for ignoring and disobeying what God has decreed. In part of his message, Pastor Joseph illustrated how those of us who have suffered in the past because of our earthly father, can have a resulting difficulty in accepting God as our Heavenly Father. However, we must get beyond this syndrome if we are to ever mature in God. The past can never be fixed. Don't fixate on the past, living perpetually in bitterness, hatred, and refugee status. Trust God's heart! Look forward and work for a bright future He has planned for us!


