Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught on "The Oneness of God," using Deuteronomy 6:4 as his main text. He recited and/or referenced many other verses. The historical (and false) assertion of Trinitarian scholarship is that the first century church of the apostles supposedly did not have a clear, established Christology. It is known that the doctrine of the Trinity, which they admit cannot be deduced from the Scriptures alone, was revealed hundreds of years later, arising in the church over time. This is in stark contrast to the many clear verses that prove that the first century church had a solid Christological understanding and a clear confession (that Jesus is the Lord, i.e. YHWH, the LORD God of the Old Testament). Also, their Jewish monotheism (their accurate oneness view of God) wasn't at all offended by their declaration of faith that the Son of God, the man Christ Jesus, was and is the human manifestation of the one true God (not a manifestation of some secondary divine person "within" God). Paul wrote to the Colossians that "in Him [Christ] dwelleth all the fulness of the godhead [deity] bodily" (Colossians 2:9). The Lord's name, Jesus, means YHWH-Savior, or YHWH-is-Salvation (aka Yahweh-Savior, sometimes [mis]spelled as Jehovah-Savior). Many false assumptions, mistaken viewpoints, and straw-man arguments were debunked, including the baseless accusation that ancient Modalists supposedly believed that God sequentially changed from Father to Son and morphed from Son to Holy Spirit, and an equally baseless accusation that modern Oneness adherents believe that as well, effectively making the title "Modalist" a misleading pejorative while simultaneously labeling us with it. No extant writings of the Modalists survive to allow them to express their views, and we should be cautious about allowing their detractors to define their views. Likewise, Trinitarians should not be the source of ideas about what we believe. The truth of the Oneness of God is simple and clear.

Pastor Joseph preached "Going For the Gold" using several texts including Zechariah 13:7-9 (God's people will be tried and come forth as gold that is purified by fire), and Ephesians 6:10-18 (put on the full armor of God so that you can take your stand against the devil's wiles, or schemes). We must love the Lord with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength. We must give 100% in living for Him. 99.5% won't do. Just as an athlete who hopes to win a gold medal in the Olympic games spends his or her life in careful discipline regarding every area of life (what to eat, when to sleep, when to wake, how to train, what behaviors to abstain from, what foods, drinks, and drugs to avoid, what friendships to have, and what associations to withdraw from) so also we must be totally dedicated in our service to the Lord. God is trying to make us pure gold, to get us ready for eternity! "Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin which doth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us" (Hebrews 12:1). In our stand, we must back one another up, fight for our brother, and maintain and defend unity in the household of faith. Giving all doesn't mean we've no time for fun. We need joy in the journey! "A merry heart doeth good like a medicine: but a broken spirit drieth the bones" (Prov. 17:22).

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught "The Blessing of Holy Living" using Deut. 28 as his main text. The Bible says significant things about eternal life—the "hereafter"—but it also says a great deal about normal life in the "here and now." Living for the Lord in true holiness not only offers potential rewards in the next life, but it also greatly increases our chances of having a blessed life in the natural, here on Earth. In Deut. 28, the Lord God laid out a powerful promise of many great blessings **if** the people would obey His commands, yet He also prophesied terrible curses upon them **if** they disobeyed after having known His commands and after having enjoyed a relationship with Him. Many people like to read about the potential blessings and stop there. But the passage says much more. To whom much is given, much shall be required. Many blessings in life can be traced to a single moment in time when we made a wise decision, and much terrible suffering can result from a single moment of indiscretion.


