## Last Sunday AM

Elder Hoskins preached "Seasons of Waiting" using Ecclesiastes 3:1 for his text. There is a time/season for every purpose, including waiting on God. "They that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength" (Isaiah 40:26). To "wait" can mean to guard, dwell, live, to remain and stay, to trust, to stand and hold out, to stay until something expected takes place. It also means to be fully prepared, to be ready. Are you "loaded for bear"? Are you fully prepared, especially for confrontation? There is a time to prepare ourselves, in order to defend our families and church from trouble. We need to keep watch and take precautions. To wait on God is a time of taking care of things beforehand. We need to be on guard against spiritual danger and guard against failure. We need to bind together as a church, meeting together as an assembly. Part of our effort to be prepared and stay prepared requires us to prioritize. "Seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness" (Matthew 6:33). "Set your affection on things above" (Colossians 3:1-2). "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (James 5:16). Effectual means legally binding or of legal force. Through faith we can command mountains to be moved! (See Mark 11:22-23.) There is nothing too big or too small for God to do. We must wait on God during our season of waiting. We have no option of quitting!

## Last Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Through The Fire" using Genesis 3:23-24 and Acts 2:1-4 for his texts. Mankind started out in innocence and perfection in the Garden of Eden. Because of their choice to sin, Adam and Eve were cast out of the garden, and the Lord blocked the way back with a flaming sword. The Bible tells us that the word of God is the sword of the Spirit. The Bible also tells us that our God is a consuming fire. There is only one way to have the curse rolled back and to mature in Christ; only way to have our impurities burned away and find perfection. The way is Jesus, through His word and His Spirit. We must allow the sword to cut on us surgically, and allow the Fire that consumes—the fire of the Holy Ghost—burn in us. When we receive the Holy Ghost and are obedient to His word, it allows us to pass through the sword of flame to reenter paradise. Being baptized with Holy Ghost fire is essential for salvation and empowerment for service in His kingdom. Let's go through the fire!

## Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught "Overcoming Bitterness and Anger" using Ephesians 4:31-32 as his text. There are some things to put away (v. 31): bitterness, wrath, anger, clamour, evil speaking, and malice. And there are some things to embrace (v. 32): "And be ye kind one to another, tender-hearted, forgiving one another, even as God for Christ's sake hath forgiven you." Bitterness includes being sharp and disagreeable; harsh; severe; piercing. Being bitter is characterized by strong feelings of resentment, hatred, cynicism, etc. Hebrews 12:15 warns that a root of bitterness can cause many to be defiled. We are to be diligent against it, so we don't fail of the grace of God. Anger isn't necessarily sinful, but it easily leads to sin, such as outbursts of rage with evil speech, railing, or violence, and even developing into a grudge, revenge, malice, or bitterness. Don't suppress anger, but also don't vent it. Instead use biblical

methods of addressing the matter. If possible, address it before the day is out (see Ephesians 4:26-27). Jesus taught that going to one another in a timely manner to resolve the matter soon is of utmost importance (Matthew 5:22-25). Don't be angry without a just cause: think and pray first. Don't let anger lead to sinful speech or action: develop strategies of waiting and operating by preestablished ethical rules of conduct that apply to all situations. Don't let anger remain; instead, seek resolution and reconciliation (see Matthew 18). We are exhorted to (1) Give situations to God through prayer and faith. (2) Realize that you are the one who continues to suffer because of your bitterness. (3) Seek reconciliation if possible, as Christ has forgiven you (Ephesians 4:32). (4) Even if the other party does not cooperate, you can seek resolution (closure); examples: letter, biblical counseling, new relationships. (5) Trust God to bring good out of bad. Benefits of enduring adversity include humility, focusing on priorities, and dependence upon God.

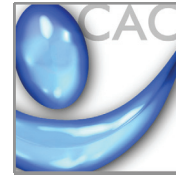
