Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught Lesson 1 of CAC's Pentecostal Distinctives Series, "The Nature of God." Topics included God's existence, nature, oneness, and morality, and the identity of Jesus Christ as the human manifestation of the one God. Arguments for God's existence are seen in causation, design, being, morality, congruity, and from faith. Scripture reveals aspects of God's nature. He possesses spirituality, life, individuality, rationality, invisibility, self-existence, eternality, omnipresence,

attributes include holiness, justice, righteousness, love, mercy, grace, faithfulness, truth, and goodness. The Word stresses His absolute monotheism. God's oneness is the most foundational truth of the Bible (see Deut. 6:4-9 and Mark 12:28-30). God's oneness is the emphasis in both the Old Testament (Isaiah 37:16; 42:8; 43:10-11; 44:6, 8, 24; 45:5-6, 21-23; 46:5, 9; 52:6; 54:5) and New Testament (Galatians 3:20; 1 Cor. 8:4, 6; James 2:19). Some verses typically twisted against God's Oneness were dealt with, such as Genesis 1:26 ("Let us make..He made"), which does not prove a trinity or multiple divine persons beside the one true God (see Isa. 44:24; Eph. 1:11). There is only one God and one mediator, the man Christ Jesus, 1 Tim. 2:5; John 17:3. Biblical terms were defined, such as Father, Holy Spirit, Son, and Word. Nonbiblical terminology was discussed, such as "Trinity," which never appears in Scripture. The Bible never says the "holy three" but the "Holy One." "Three persons" never appears in Scripture. Hebrews 1:1-3 has the only biblical use of "person" in relation to God; it says the Son is the expression of the one "person" (substance) of God. Jesus is the one God manifested in the flesh, Colossians 2:9; 1 Timothy 3:16.

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught a lesson on Temperance entitled, "Who's In Charge Here?" using Galatians 5:23 (fruit of the Spirit) and II Peter 1:6 for his texts. Having temperance means showing self-control/self-discipline (I Cor. 9:24-27). It includes

Pastor Joseph preached “Wait For It” from Malachi 3:1 and Habakkuk 2:3. The later text (in the NIV) reads as: “For the revelation awaits an appointed time; it speaks of the end and will not prove false. Though it lingers, **wait for it**; it will certainly come and will not delay.” Interestingly, the passage says that although the fulfillment of God’s revelation tattles, at the appointed time it will not tarry. God waits until the time is right, then He moves quickly! Malachi 3:1 is a prophecy about the Messiah and John the Baptist. Regarding Jesus Christ, the verse foretells: “the LORD, whom

ye seek, shall suddenly come to his temple.” When God manifested Himself in flesh as Jesus Christ, He was the one true God, the LORD – YHWH or Yahweh (aka Jehovah) of the Old Testament – come “suddenly” to His temple (i.e. the man Christ Jesus). Furthermore we, as Spirit filled believers, are now the “body of Christ” upon the earth. Thus on the Day of Pentecost, the rushing mighty wind and infilling of the Spirit came “suddenly” as the Lord came into His temple! You may not understand why God’s promises to you hold a delay in fulfillment, but trust that He is wise and in the right moment He will act “suddenly” to fulfill what He has pledged to us!


