Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught the second half of Lesson 2 of CAC's Pentecostal Distinctives Series, "The Doctrine of Jesus Christ" and taught all of Lesson 3, "The Doctrine of Salvation." Topics from the completion of Lesson 2 included: the distinction between Christ's deity and humanity; the union of Christ's deity and humanity; the purpose of the incarnation; the death, burial, and resurrection of Jesus, as well as His ascension and exaltation. Regarding these events, we touched on their essentiality, purpose, extent, and significance. Topics from Lesson 3 included: one plan of salvation; salvation history; God's eternal plan and purpose; four aspects of conversion unto salvation (justification, regeneration, adoption, and sanctification); grace and faith; repentance from sin; water baptism in Jesus name; and the baptism of the Holy Spirit (the infilling of the Holy Ghost). This conversion process constitutes the New Birth.

Last Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Well" from Isaiah 12. We all have a well inside us, and without God inhaled to fill it, our well is dry. We seldom think of Isaiah as being a psalmist, yet the twelfth chapter of Isaiah is indeed a prophetic hymn or song, including such wonderful and well-loved phrases as "With joy shall ye draw water out of the wells of salvation," and "God is become my salvation." In Hebrew, this latter verse could literally be translated as "God is become my JESUS"! This world around us is overly materialistic, immensely wicked and carnal, and obsessed with all the wrong things. Many think they will be fine in eternity because they feel "pretty good" about themselves, and they think God is soft on sin. The Bible proves otherwise. Consider the global Flood, and the destruction of Sodom and Gomorrah. Because of the wickedness of mankind, the judgment of God is hanging over this generation. The sense of impending doom is striking fear in the hearts of many. Yet we as believers must make a conscious decision to join Isaiah in declaring, "I will trust and not be afraid." The count of all biblical uses of terms such as "fear not," "have no fear," and "be not afraid" etc, equals some 365 instances; enough for each day of the year! While others are hoarding gold and stockpiling months' or years' worth of water and dried foods, we must heed the voice of our Lord, who taught that God cares for us much more than the lilies of the field who are gloriously arrayed and well cared for. Don't panic! We have a well inside of us to draw from! No matter what lies ahead, the Lord knows how to take care of His people! He will not fail us!

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph taught the conclusion (part 2) of an important lesson on "Knowing God's Word." Topics included: we have God's Word; the Bible is God's Word; the trustworthiness of the Bible (inspiration, canon, text, and translations); and a final conclusion on how to apply all that we have learned. We all ought to read the Bible daily; we ought to read the entire Bible through (using, for instance, a "read the Bible in a year" program available for free via any one of several Bible apps for mobile phones and/or portable devices). New believers could *start* by reading Luke, Acts, Psalms, and Proverbs. We all ought to study. Seek out topics, Bible characters, books, color codes, cross references, notes and outlines. Meditate and memorize!



