#### Last Sunday AM - Pentecostal Distinctives Series, Sunday #8

Pastor Joseph taught "Spiritual Gifts" parts 3 & 4. Part 3 was about prophecy. Part 4 was about speaking in tongues. The basic definition of prophecy is "inspired utterance." As a verb, it can occur as either "forth-telling" (calling the past forward) or "foretelling" (speaking the future before it happens). Prophecy can be either "general" (such as Ezekiel 37:4) or a specific gift (see I Cor. 12:4-11). When distinguished from speaking in an unknown tongue, it is a supernatural utterance directly from God in a known language. It can occur outside the office of prophet or within it (see Ephesians 4:11-16). Biblical examples: Agabus and famine, Acts 11:27-28; Daughters of Philip, Acts 21:9-11; Prophecy to Paul, Acts 21:4, 10-11, 13. The recipient must properly apply the prophecy. Speaking in tongues is a spiritual gift, and there are different kinds of tongues (see I Cor. 12:10). It is unknown to the speaker (I Cor. 14:2, 4, 14) and the language could be either human or angelic (Acts 2:5-11; I Cor. 13:1. There are basically three uses in Scripture: (1) Initial Sign of Holy Spirit Baptism, (2) Personal Devotion ("prayer language"), (3) Public Utterance to Be Interpreted ("tongues for interpretation"). To interpret means "to explain the meaning of" or "to translate orally." Guidelines for order regarding these and other gifts are found in I Corinthians 14:26-40.

#### Last Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Root or Fruit" – about being rooted and grounded in love. He used several passages including Luke 13:6-9, Ephesians 3:8-11, 17-21, II Tim. 2:6, and James 5:7-20. God's eternal purpose for those in His kingdom is a majestic display of His love for us. Ultimately, the most important skill and trait we can learn, as we mature, is love. During the first three years of a tree's life, the husbandman must wisely refuse to let the tree flower and bud. One can get either root or fruit during these formative years, but not both. If the tree is to have good, deep, healthy roots, the formation of its roots must not be hindered or distracted by trying to produce fruit too early. The plan of God is to have his people be right on the inside first, which leads us to eventually demonstrate being right on the outside. Where there is root, there will eventually be fruit.

#### Last Wednesday

Jr Elder Rusty Sandy preached about being ready for the coming of the Lord. It so happened that back when he preached his very first sermon at the age of 12, his topic was the same. We must not let anything hinder us from being ready for the coming of the Lord. Nothing in this life is worth losing the next life! We must be determined to live for God with all our heart, soul, mind and strength. Elder Les Benedum followed afterwards, and preached a message entitled "Resistance" – encouraging us to not resist God's guidance in our lives, and to not resist his instructions on how we should help others. Be "the path of least resistance" and permit the Spirit's powerful flow of "spiritual electricity" in us!

# Today's Special Events: Pentecost Sunday! (Whitsunday)

Foundational to Christianity is the **outpouring of the Holy**Spirit on those who believe in Jesus and ask for God's Holy
Spirit. The initial outpouring occurred seven weeks after the resurrection of Jesus Christ (see Acts 2:1-4), on the ancient Jewish festival called the "Feast of Weeks" or "Feast of Pentecost" (for more information see Exo. 34:22 and



Deut. 16:10). Whitsunday is a name used on some calendars because of the white garments that were worn by some who were baptized in a vigil during the holiday; Pentecost is Greek for "the fiftieth" (as in, the fiftieth day after the second day of Passover).
