Last Sunday AM - Pentecostal Sunday!

Pastor Joseph preached "Feast of Shavuot" (Pentecost) using Acts 2:1-4 as his text. The Day of Pentecost in Acts 2 was a holiday that Jews had been celebrating for centuries, ever since the Lord gave them the Torah (writings given through Moses) when they met God at Mt. Sinai in the wilderness. God assigned significance to that day, which He then amplified and increased by later using the same date to pour out His Spirit on the Church in its infancy in Jerusalem under the leadership of the Apostles, after Jesus' ascension. The giving of the Torah was God's Word written "outwardly" on tables of stone and on scrolls. The Holy Ghost baptism is God's Word being written "inwardly" in fleshly tables of the heart! The baptism of the Holy Ghost is not some added blessing that just makes things somewhat better for a Christian. Furthermore, the baptism of the Spirit is a personal experience, intended by God for each and every believer living during the age of the New Covenant Church. If you have not received this wonderful experience, you're selling yourself short! Claim what God has for you. Experience Pentecost!

Two chains and two guards held him behind two gates. Yet it took only one God sending one angel to get him out! What was Peter doing during this time?
