Last Sunday AM – Father's Day

Pastor Joseph preached a special Father's Day sermon entitled "The Chariot of Israel" using II Kings 2:1-15. One of the consequences of the original sin of Adam and Eve is that we must suffer separation from some of those that we love because of death. Our hearts ache as we miss some precious people of God awaiting us in heaven; those who mentored us, loved us, trained us, and helped us, and then were taken from us to glory. Some of them were biological fathers. Others of them were spiritual fathers. As much as we hate being separated from them, in a sense, the separation will only serve to help us appreciate when we are eventually reunited, then having all of eternity with no more death. Until then we echo the mournful cry of Elisha when his mentor Elijah was taken away from him: "My father! My father! The chariots and horsemen of Israel!" In the meantime, if we truly love these precious mentors who have passed on, we should show our love by living for God with all our hearts. Like Elisha, we can have a double portion of their spirit!

Jr. Elder Baron Claypool preached "Which Way Will You Go?" Abraham and Lot had been blessed with increased cattle until they had to separate because the land and resources were being fought over by their servants. Abraham offered Lot his choice of which direction to go. Lot made a choice not based on God's leading, or on godly counsel, and without adequate concern for the spiritual welfare of his family. He chose the "well watered plains of Sodom and Gomorrah," and the rest is history. He lost his home and riches in the judgment of God on the wickedness of the sinful cities. God sent angels to spare his family, but his wife's heart was ensnared. She turned back and was turned into a pillar of salt. Abraham preferred his nephew, allowing him the first choice. He then sought the will of God as the primary direction he chose, and the rest is history. He went on to become the father of the faithful. Today the same question faces us: which way will you go? Pastor Joseph then preached "Anoint the Shield" from Isaiah 21:5. The prophet had foreseen the Lord's judgment on Babylon, and what he saw was so terrible it struck fear in his heart. Yet the princes and leaders were eating, drinking, and making merry, as though nothing was on the horizon. Isaiah chided and rebuked them, demanding that they prepare by anointing the shields with oil. The shields were made of wood, sometimes covered with tough animal hide. Keeping the shields oiled was essential, because a shield with a dry, cracked animal skin, stretched over dried, brittle wood, would easily be broken. Likewise, today more than ever, we need the anointing of God's Spirit on our shield of faith! The enemy's "yoke shall be destroyed because of the anointing" (Isaiah 10:27).

Last Wednesday

We were blessed by the ministries of veteran missionaries, Lee and Becky Sherry. They have served for many years, both in Australia (first appointed in

October, 1967), and the South Pacific—Fiji and now the nations of Vanuatu and New Caledonia. While in Australia, the Sherry's founded a church, organized a local Bible school, and evangelized through various outreaches. After 20-some years in Australia, the Sherry's transferred to the South Pacific islands. Everywhere they have been, they have either built or continued Bible schools. Bro. Sherry is now the field superintendent of the UPC in Vanuatu and the UPCI representative to New Caledonia. The Ni-Vanuatu Bible college and ministerial training are top priorities for them. Sis Sherry preached from Galatians 4:19 about traveling in birth until Christ be formed in those we are winning for the Lord. A true, mature servant of the Lord will be willing to suffer pain, enduring whatever it takes for the lost to be saved, out of love for souls. In Acts 9 we read of how the Lord looked beyond the wrongful past of Saul (later called Paul) and saw his potential. He sent word to him prophesying what things he would suffer for the Lord's name. We today need to know church is not about entertaining us. We are here to serve people, to see the lost reached. Bro Sherry relayed many powerful testimonies of what God has done overseas.

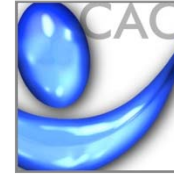
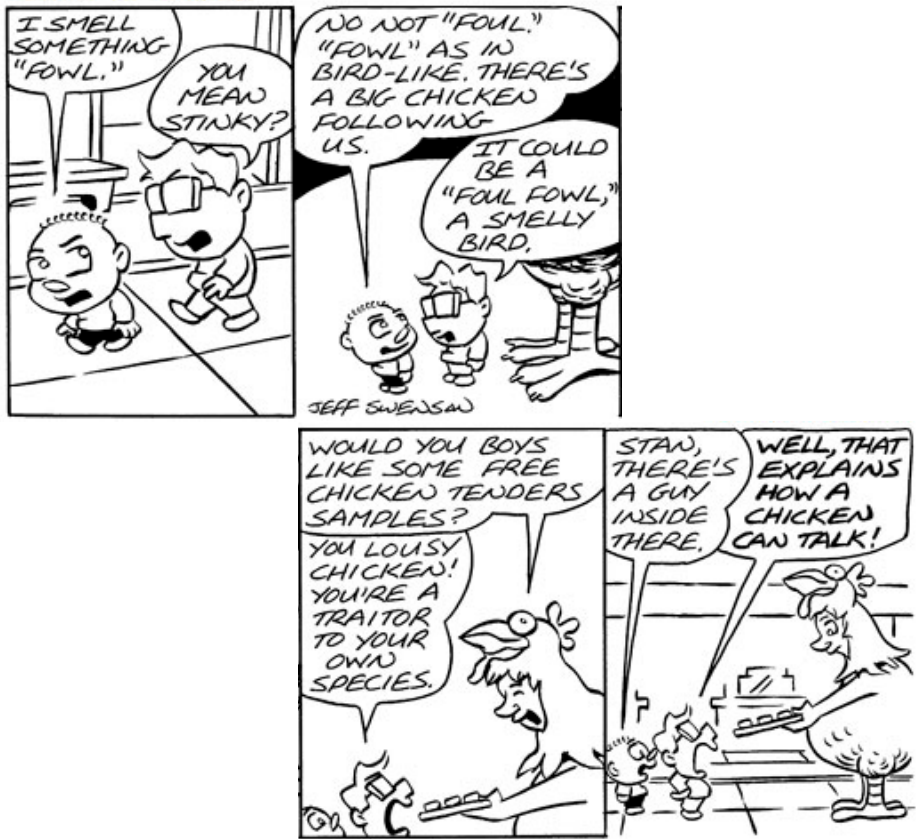
