Sunday School Picnic at Veteran's Park

Pastor Joseph preached "Good News!" from Romans 1:16. The word *gospel* is the translation of *euangelion* (Gk.), which combines *angelia* (Greek for message) and the Greek prefix *eu* (meaning well or good). So, the gospel is the "good message." The Christian gospel is carefully summarized in I Corinthians 15:3, 4 as having these basic essentials (1) God incarnated in flesh as the Son, Jesus Christ (2) His death on the cross to atone (pay) for our sins, (3) His resurrection and ascension, victorious over death and validating our justification (4) the prophetic promise that He will return for His people. Basically, the death, burial, resurrection, ascension and soon return of Jesus. The Bible's doctrine of justification is crucial; God saves not based on us having a perfect track record. God accredits His own righteousness to believers because of their faith. Real faith is always obedient. A lack of obedience always proves a false faith as "dead." Thus, to truly *believe* the Gospel *always* leads to obedience (which initially consists of faith, repentance, and the *new birth* of water & Spirit). Acts 2:38 shows how to fulfill John 3:3-5 regarding being born of water and born of Spirit. **The Lord anointed this worship service, and moved powerfully during the altar service.**

Wednesday

CAC's former pastor, Rev. Terry Null, preached "Meeting God on the Road of Impossibilities" from Ezekiel 37:1-5. This passage tells of a mighty vision shown to Ezekiel while he was caught up in the Spirit. The vision was prophetic; dry bones "living" and rising to become a mighty army foretold the reforming of Israel as a nation in 1948. It may also have portent with regard to the Rapture. However, Bro. Null was anointed of God to focus on yet another way to ponder this amazing passage. On Ezekiel's way to seeing the impossible happen, what did he undergo in preparation for the miracle? The Bible says (1) the hand of the Lord was upon him, (2) he was caught up in the Spirit, and (3) the Lord led him through the valley of dry bones. We need to realize that before our church can see *all* of our future miracles of revival, strength, and blessing (even financial), we must be willing to let the Lord lead us through the valley! We are, in fact, being led through that valley now, and we have been for some time. "Can these bones live?" The wise answer was "O Lord God, thou knowest." **There was a mighty touch of faith in this service, and thousands of dollars were pledged by faith, to be given for missions and for the church's capital campaign.** Thank you, Jesus!

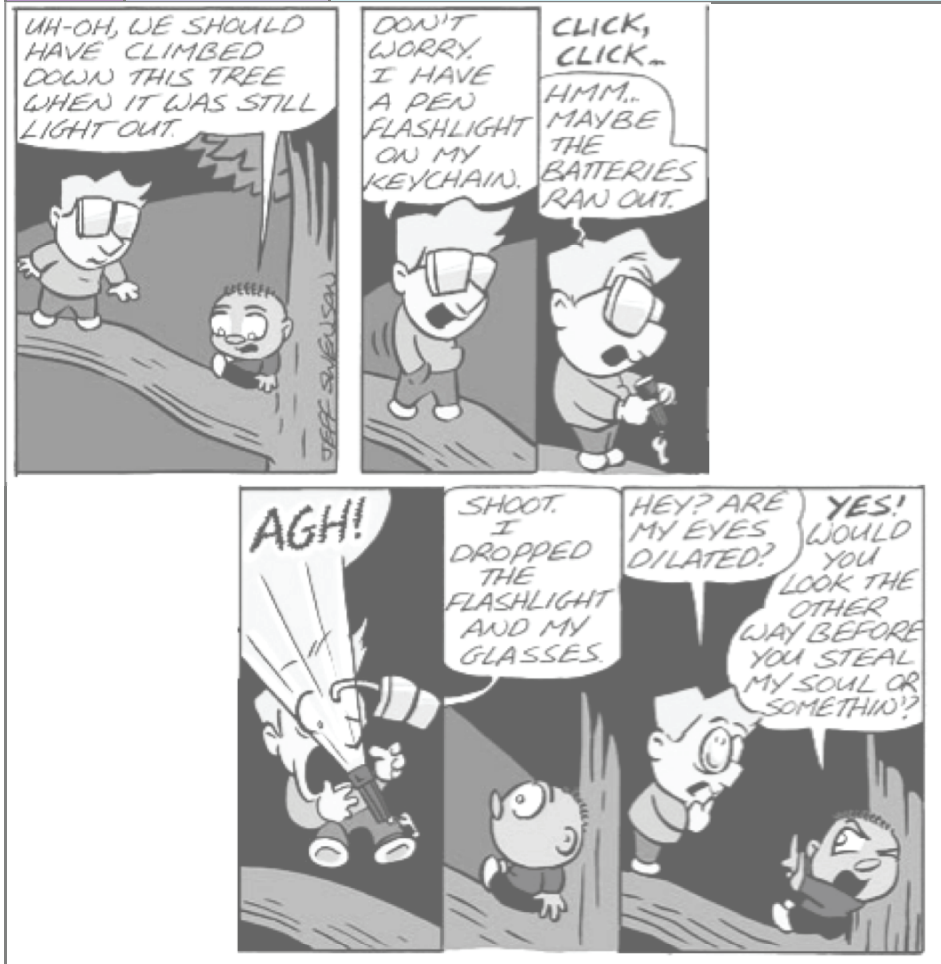

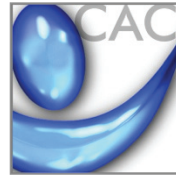
