Last Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Times of Refreshing From the Presence of the Lord" based on Acts 3:19. This message underscored the importance being filled with the Holy Ghost. To be filled with the Spirit is essential for one's salvation. Also, regarding tongues, the pastor addressed the fact of marked difference in purpose, function, and administration between "tongues as evidence" and "tongues in the gifts of the Spirit" that may follow after one is first filled with the Spirit. He described the gifts of the Spirit as being distributed by God as He wills across all Spirit-filled believers, and that His use of various believers to speak forth or go forth and act or work in the Spirit, is somewhat like a skilled musician playing a piano. As an artist, the musician will strike many different keys during a song, just as God gifts and speaks/acts through many different believers in the assembly.

Last Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Those Who Are Perishing." His title was taken from a phrase used several times in the New Testament—for examples: "For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God" (I Corinthians 1:18) and "And even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing" (II Corinthians 4:3). He then preached how short life is, and how important it is to keep our priorities straight. He brought several illustrations of real-life lessons learned from his first boss. Ken Norris was the manager at the Brookshire's grocery store where Bro. Joseph held his first job. That store manager also happened to be a denominational preacher. Pastor Joseph remembered that boss explaining that all the produce in the store was in the process of dying. He gave two analogies. (1) All the lost souls around us are dying. If we don't reach them with the gospel, they will perish. (2) Our natural bodies are in the process of passing away. If we don't work for God now, we will lose our chance to use this life for His glory. We had a wonderful time of communion and foot washing at the conclusion of this service. God anointed these precious rites in a glorious way. Thank God for the body and blood of Christ!

Last Wednesday

Pastor Joseph preached/taught "A Few Important Rules" using II Timothy 2:5 and Jude 1:3 to launch preparatory remarks leading up to an expository reading of Ephesians 4. Paul's words of "He that striveth for the mastery must strive lawfully" have been aptly translated as "if anyone competes as an athlete, he does not receive the victor's crown unless he competes according to the rules." If you want to win, you must obey the rules or the win is worthless because you sacrificed your integrity to make it happen. The words "contend" (Jude 1:3; "earnestly contend for the faith") and "strive" (II Timothy 2:5, an athlete competing) are similar in this usage. When we strive or contend or "fight" for correct doctrine, biblical holiness, and compliance to biblical principles, we must do so "according to the rules" (lawfully). We then noted a few important rules from Ephesians 4. Be humble, gentle; patient, loving, etc.

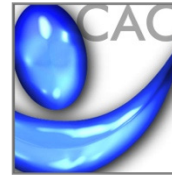
Humor!
