Pastor Joseph preached "The Antidote" from Acts 10:44-48. We all started our life with the sin curse. This leads us to backwards thinking, an upside down value system, and wrong priorities. To further compound this, we can also be influenced by wicked spirits of demons (fallen angels). They strive to get us to view life through a skewed lens that causes us to expect the worst and to imagine offense where perhaps none was intended. One's spirit can be so infected with these other wicked spirits, that it is similar to your body being infected by a virus or a bacteria. The baptism of the Holy Ghost is the antidote to all that is wrong with our thinking and any curse of sin and any infection of any wicked spirit that might cause our human spirit to be twisted, wrong, or against godliness. We need the Holy Ghost every day of our lives! Not just a one time experience, but a way of life!

Pastor Joseph preached "Hell Cannot Stop A Worshiper" using II Samuel 6 for his text. David danced before the Lord, but his wife, Michal, despised him in her heart and mocked his worship. There were many things in David's life that he did not view as worth fighting over. He did not fight to take the crown or the throne from Saul, and later he did not fight his son, Absalom, to keep his throne or crown. He did not esteem limelight, status, authority, office, or position as things worthy of standing up and fighting for. However, when the Philistine giant, Goliath of Gath, mocked the Hebrews and their God, David did view the honor of God's name as worth fighting for! Today we can defend the honor of God's name by representing Him well through holiness in speech, lifestyle, adornment, and attire. Also David did feel that his worship was something worth fighting for. When his wife, Michal, mocked his worship, then he declared (paraphrase) "I wasn't worshipping for you or to impress anyone else. I was worshipping God! You're not going to get me to stop worshipping through your mockery." He basically said, "If you think I'm shouting and praising now, you ain't seen nothing yet!" Why does the devil try to intimidate us and try to get us to willfully let go of our worship? He knows that Hell cannot stop a true worshiper! As long as we hold onto our worship, we're unstoppable.

Pastor Joseph preached (from Philippians 2:5) on maintaining a sweet communion with God so that our relationship with Him gets closer and more intimate with each passing day from now on throughout all eternity. The text verse says, "Let this mind be in you, which was also in Christ Jesus." Only by getting to know Him more and more can we have His mindset. Just as sweet married couples that are together for decades can finish one another's sentences because they know one another so well, we also can get to know God so well that we have his mindset/thinking as our own. Some people waste their whole life being religious without ever really getting to know God. This is why some foolishly think, for example, that God has no sense of humor! If only they knew Him. Don't ever lose your laughter; it is so precious!

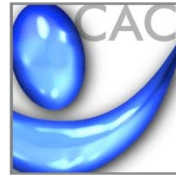
