Rev. Rick Wyser preached "What Manner of Love" from I John 3:1-2. John, the "Apostle of Love" (and author of the epistle in which our text is found), revealed that he was caught off guard by the amazing love of God. Everyone knows the Bible says "God is love," but how do we grasp this? If John, who laid his head on Jesus' chest, and was the "beloved" disciple expressed difficulty in comprehending God's love, surely we all need a new revelation of God. John said, "Behold" — calling our attention to (as unto something extraordinary) this amazing "manner of love." When Jesus calmed the angry sea, they said "what manner of man!" John perceiving the love of Christ, used the same wording "what manner of love!" God has emotions, but none of them master him. Love is not an emotion, but a commitment, and this commitment is at the helm of God's existence. Nowhere in the Bible do we read, "God is anger" or "God is hate" yet we read "God is love." Love is the only principle that adequately describes God's concept of mastery. God's love is a pure love, and it is a conquering force! He loves us forevermore.

Rev. Rick Wyser preached "Ships That Never Sail" from I Kings 22:48. Jehoshaphat was a great king over God's people, and a great educator. He brought great reform to the courts. He accomplished much. However, the great ships that he commissioned were built, but they never sailed. He had them built in Tarshish for the purpose of sailing to Ophir to trade for gold. However, they were damaged at Ezion-geber during land transport, and the scripture declares they never sailed. Somehow, they never took the time or resources to repair them. Time is our gift—our opportunity to prepare for eternity. If you don't choose a side in this war between good and evil, you will by default be on the side of evil. No choice is a choice of 'no.' Thus it is deathly serious to "halt between two opinions." This is life! Don't wait to do something for God. Time is passing. Don't waste it! The terrace of indecision leads to the Dead Sea. Either you will make decisions, or events will make the decisions for you! Don't suffer the tragedy of missed chance!

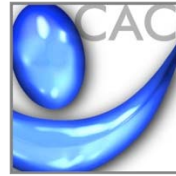
