Pastor Joseph preached "Times of Refreshing" from Acts 3:19-21 & Revelation 22:17. When God told Abram to leave his home city, it was not only because of getting him away from his ungodly people. Part of it seems to have been getting him to some place where the land was a factor. Whenever God tells you to move you'd best move! Times of refreshing come from the Spirit of the Lord. Don't despair when things are dry; God is still God! Church attendance is very crucial, even necessary. His anointing in our life is essential. We need to have His Spirit flowing through us to minister to others and to quench the thirst of our souls. Don't leave true holiness or this precious one-God, Apostolic message. Being blessed by the times of refreshing from the presence of the Lord is predicated on genuine repentance. When God told John to write to the seven churches, His message was consistent: **repent!** When we have genuine repentance, we will receive times of refreshing that are so crucial in our daily lives. Pastor Joseph preached "Tarry Until Pentecost" from I Corinthians 16:7-9. We should always have a hunger and thirst for the things of God. Daily we should desire to know more and more about Him. Pray for revival, the restoration of the presence of God. When adversaries get in your way, keep praying, keep fasting, keep preaching, keep teaching, and keep witnessing of the things of God. Be consistent in your walk with God. Never give up!

Sis. Hannah Sandy preached from James 2:14-26. Faith is believing and trusting God is going to do something, but faith without works is dead. Noah believed that God was going to send rain and destroy the wicked, but if he hadn't built an ark he would have been destroyed like everyone else. 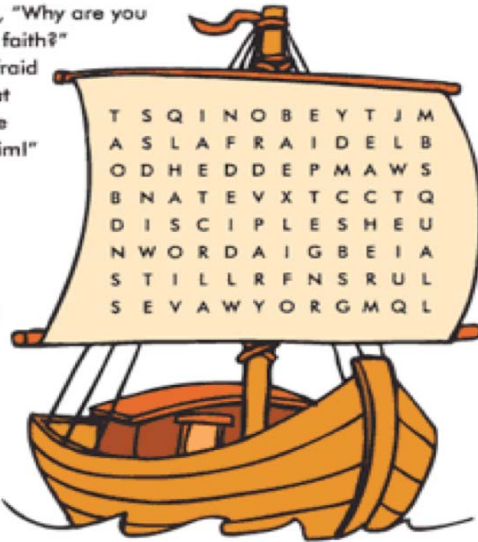
Jesus Calms A Storm

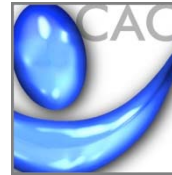

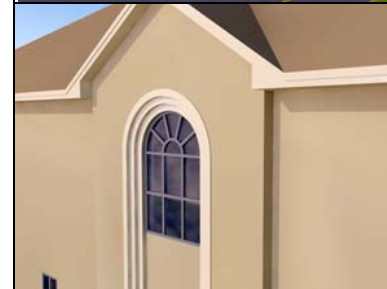
