Sunday AM & PM - Creation Seminar

AM: Our special guest speaker, Creation Evangelist Steve Grohman, delivered the opening session of his excellent Creation Seminar, with topics such as the age of the earth; why the theory of evolution is patently unworkable; and many clear evidences for a young earth.

PM: In the second session of the Creation Seminar, Bro. Steve Grohman explained various ill-advised "Creation Compromises" (such as efforts to "cram" the "deep time" notions of the evolutionism camps in between the Bible's verses). He also taught about the pre-flood world, dinosaurs and man living together, and reptiles then and today.

Monday - Creation Seminar

In the third session of the Creation Seminar, Bro. Steve Grohman taught about Noah's ark and the global flood, about dinosaurs and so-called sea monsters, about the dinosaurs described in the Bible, namely Leviathan and Behemoth, and some worthy considerations of evidences that some dinosaurs are still alive today.

Tuesday - Creation Seminar

In the fourth session of the Creation Seminar, Bro. Steve Grohman disproved the fabled "Geologic Column" originally put forth by Charles Lyell. Bro. Grohman also taught on petrified objects and expounded on Darwin and friends, the fossil record, and pointed out the terrible social ills and ruthless mass murders that have been based on Darwin's evolutionism. Both Nazism and abortion are examples.

Wednesday

Bro. Steve Grohman taught/preached a sobering message entitled "Do You Really Believe the Bible?" using Hebrews 11:6, Mark 16, Mark 11:22-26, and a litany of other verses. Any person who truly believes the Bible will live holy, and will be wholly dedicated to God. Furthermore, such a person will see faith lead to results! We may claim that we believe the Bible as it is written, but do we really? When we read the many passages about true faith—such as the words of Jesus saying that a believer shall do greater works than Jesus Himself, and saying that a believer is to be able to ask God for someone to be healed and it definitely happen—do we compare those to actual experiences, find it to not be a match, and then subtlety reinterpret the passages to suit our own experiences? Or do we question our own doubts, wrong priorities, and worldly lifestyles in trying to discern why some promises of God are not happening for us? Far too many Apostolic Pentecostals live and act as though they think "Eternal Unconditional Security" is real (also called "Once Saved Always Saved"), yet they claim with their mouth that they don't accept that doctrine. Many think that all God expects of them is to show up at a few church services per month, give some money at church, and profess to be a believer. Meanwhile, the same folks are mired & paralyzed by worldly weights and sins that distract them from consecration and desensitize them to their state.
