Elder Lorren Godwin preached about seeking God from II Chronicles 7:14. God's people often fail to truly seek God. "The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much" (James 5:16). Fiery, passionate prayers change things. People pray until they get what they want and are satisfied, then quit. We ought to continue! Jesus is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him. If we are going to reach God's heart, we must fall on our face before Him with a broken heart and contrite spirit. Don't just pray a short prayer. Have a passionate desire when you pray. Crave! Be desperate! Paul said it's not what I have attained; I press forward for the prize of the high calling of God. Abraham obeyed what God said and never questioned. Joseph spent time in prayer and submitted himself to God. We need to be desperate in our walk with God and desire more. Pray with a passion!

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Be Ready" from Matthew 24:36-44, Matthew 25:1-13 & Ezekiel 36:21-27. There is no way to earn your way into Heaven. You can't earn salvation, but you can earn damnation. Throw yourself on the mercy and grace of God when you come up short. We need to be in a relationship with Him and know Him. Jesus is the Bridegroom and the Church is the Bride. We must abide in Him and He in us. Repentance, the infilling of the Holy Ghost, and baptism in the name of Jesus puts us in the Bride of Christ. Everywhere we go, we are wearing the name of Jesus. We need to be careful of what clothes we wear, what we do, where we go, and what comes out of our mouth. We must live a holy life. It will be a wonderful day for those who are ready when Jesus returns for His Bride, yet it will be a terrible day for those who aren't ready. God is loving and longsuffering, but there is coming a day that He will be a God of judgment. We need to get ready, be ready, live ready, and stay ready! 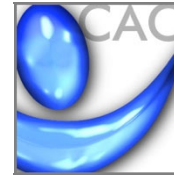
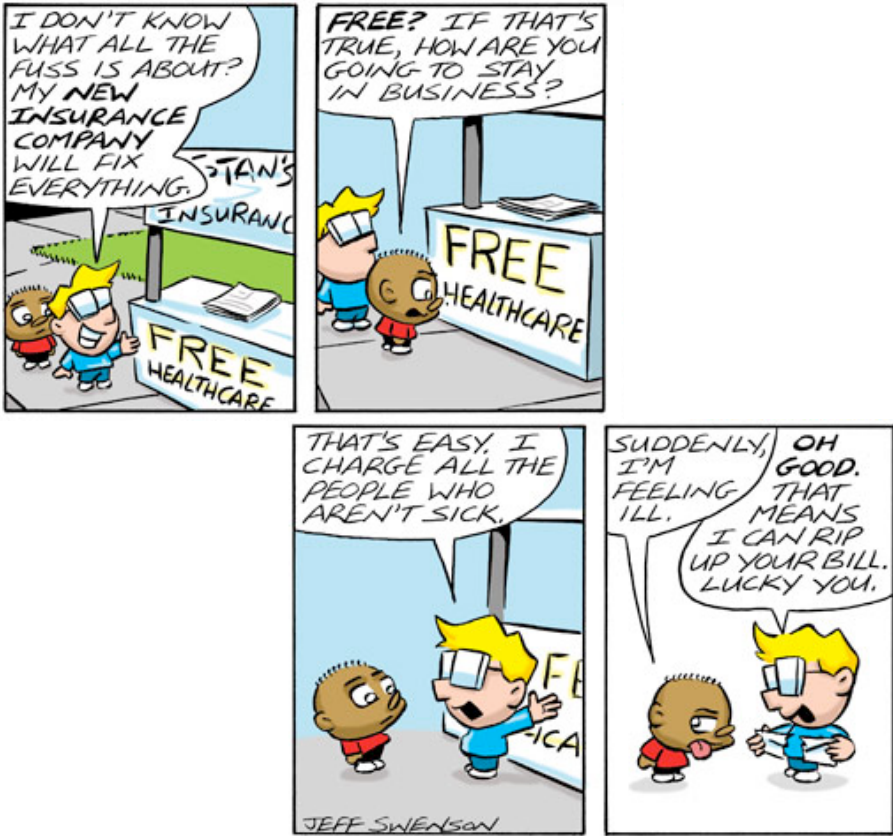
