Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "The World's Greatest Mother" from Genesis 3:9-15. Don't blame God for the sin curse. It's Adam's fault and Eve's fault. God revealed that part of the result of Eve's disobedience to God's Word would be that a woman's "desire shall be to [her] husband, and he shall rule over [her]." Marriage is wonderful if both the husband and wife "walk in the light as He is the Light." Men: never pull your wife to go against God! Woman: don't let yourself be pulled away from church or away from God. Use wisdom. When the man isn't walking with God, the woman will be stretched between man and God. The wife can advise the husband and explain to him why God's way is better. Then if he doesn't listen, turn Him over to God's hands, but never let go of God. This is the greatest mom: the one who says, "You can stretch me as far as you want, but I'll never let go of God." She tells her company, "I'm going to church. You can come with me or stay here." The one who teaches her children right from wrong. The woman who stands for God—and will not back up—is the world's greatest mother.

Pastor Joseph preached "Beyond Knowledge" from Ephesians 3:17-21 & Luke 17:11-19. God has blessed many people with great knowledge; doctors, professors, etc. Yet knowledge without the love of God will do no good. We cannot fathom the love of God. We need to be "rooted and grounded in love." God can bless us no matter where we are. Professors at institutions of higher learning will attack faith. The world is trying to indoctrinate people instead of giving them an education. You must always be ready to give an answer of your faith. Make sure your prayer life stays strong. Be humble enough to call on Jesus for help. The ten lepers cried "Jesus, Master, have mercy on us." When Jesus cleansed their leprosy, one came back to thank Him. The other nine were filled with the knowledge that they had to go show themselves to the priest. Yet Jesus told the one who returned to praise, "Thy faith hath made thee whole." God can take away our past scars!

Wednesday

Elder Lorren Godwin preached from I Kings 8:27 & I Kings 19. "But will God indeed dwell on the earth? Behold, the heaven and heaven of heavens cannot contain thee; how much less this house that I have builded?" There is no building big enough to contain God, yet we have the ability—via praise and worship—to build a house for God. God dwells within the praise of His people. When Elijah was hiding in the cave from Jezebel, a great and strong wind came, then an earthquake and a fire. Yet God's voice was not in them. The Lord's Word came in a still, small voice. God doesn't need anything fancy. He just needs one man. He just needs you to stand up and proclaim that this Apostolic way is the only way to be saved. Each one of us who are born again has a light within us. Share it or it is wasted. Jesus came to seek and to save those who are lost. We must let our light shine and share what God has done for us.

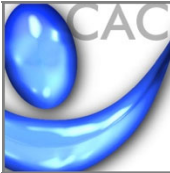
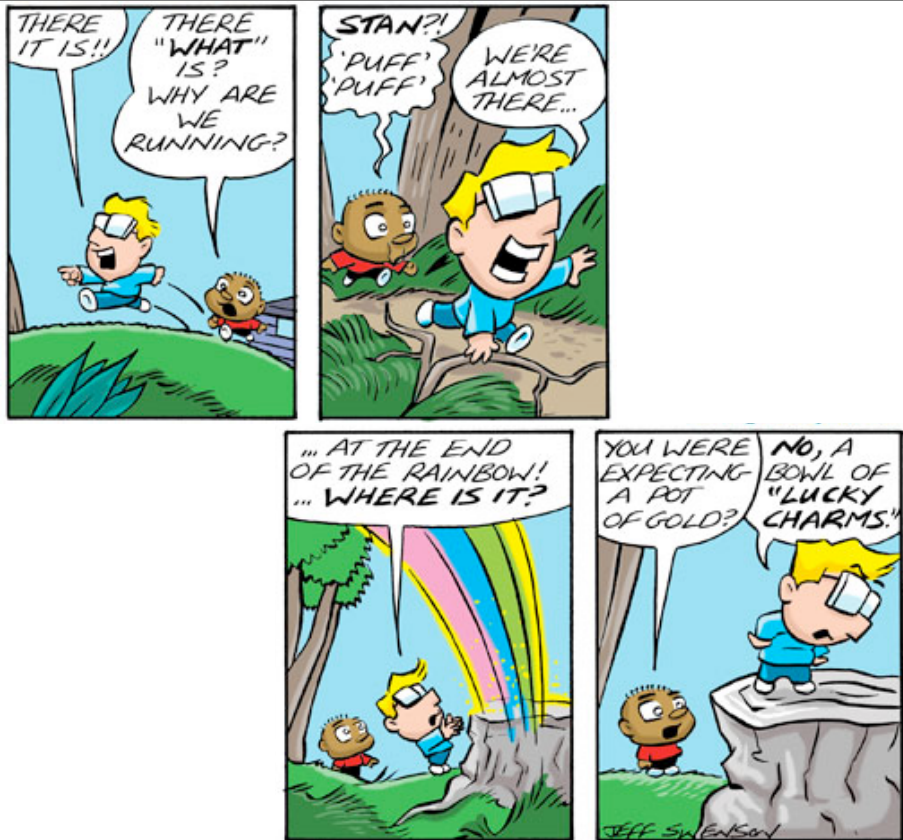
