Sunday AM – Pentecost Sunday and Biker Sunday

We were thrilled to welcome our guests from the Azusa StreetRiders motorcycle ministry. These ASRs had come from several states, even as far away as New Jersey and Missouri, to be with us for our first annual Sword Run (held the prior day) and Biker Sunday. Our special guest speaker, Evangelist Earl Rodeheaver, preached a powerful message about how God can work all things for good to them who love the Lord and are called according to His purpose. For his text, he read Acts 2:1, a perfect passage for Pentecost Sunday. Rev. Rodeheaver gave powerful testimonies about people who, even in the midst of sorrow or trials, were in fact in just the right place at the right time, and explained how God blessed and turned situations for their good. This service was signally blessed of the Holy Ghost, and several people were wondrously healed by the Lord's hand!

The evening service of our Pentecost Sunday and Biker Sunday saw significant opposition from the enemy at the start, but with the help of the Lord we overcame the opposition and there was a move of God and blessing of God's Spirit that defies description with any mere words of mortals. Evangelist Rodeheaver read from Luke 5 and John 1, and preached a powerhouse of a message entitled, "Nevertheless At Thy Word." The Lord's Spirit of prophecy was absolutely present in the service, hovering on those who responded with faith. As believers, we are charged to ignore the perceptions of the carnal senses and obey God's Word, to mighty effect. As believers we have the legal right and spiritual authority to speak the Word of God with boldness, and we ought to always exercise that right instead of being caught up in the vagaries of carnal life. The touch of God accomplished many powerful and prophetic things in our midst on this night!

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "I Will Not Be Satisfied Right Here!" from II Kings 2:1-4. The man of God was mentoring a younger minister, and as the time drew nigh for the senior man to be taken up by the Lord, the younger minister was tested (by being told to stay behind). Nevertheless, the younger man sensed the importance of the hour, and he refused to be satisfied to stay behind. His persistence and spiritual hunger led to him being used mightily by God! Elder Baron Claypool preached "The Resurrection of the Promise" from II Kings 4:8-20,28,33-36. Although both speakers had prepared separately, without comparing notes, the Lord led them both to texts in II Kings, and their messages flowed together as if they were deliberately planned together. The man of God had prophesied a promised child to a barren woman, and the promise came to pass. However, one day the promised child died. What a powerful message Elder Claypool spoke about trusting God until your promise is resurrected! The Lord is using our Elders to minister with the anointing of special guests. Thank the Lord!

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "What Is Stopping You?" from John 5:5-9. This timely and vital message had benefit for the whole church, not just the students or youth. 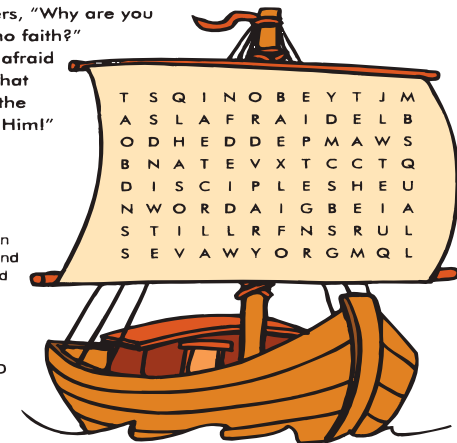
Jesus stood up and commanded the wind and the waves to stop. He said, "Quiet! Be still!" Then the wind stopped, and the lake became calm.

Find the words in the word list in the word search puzzle. Then find the same words in the story and underline them.

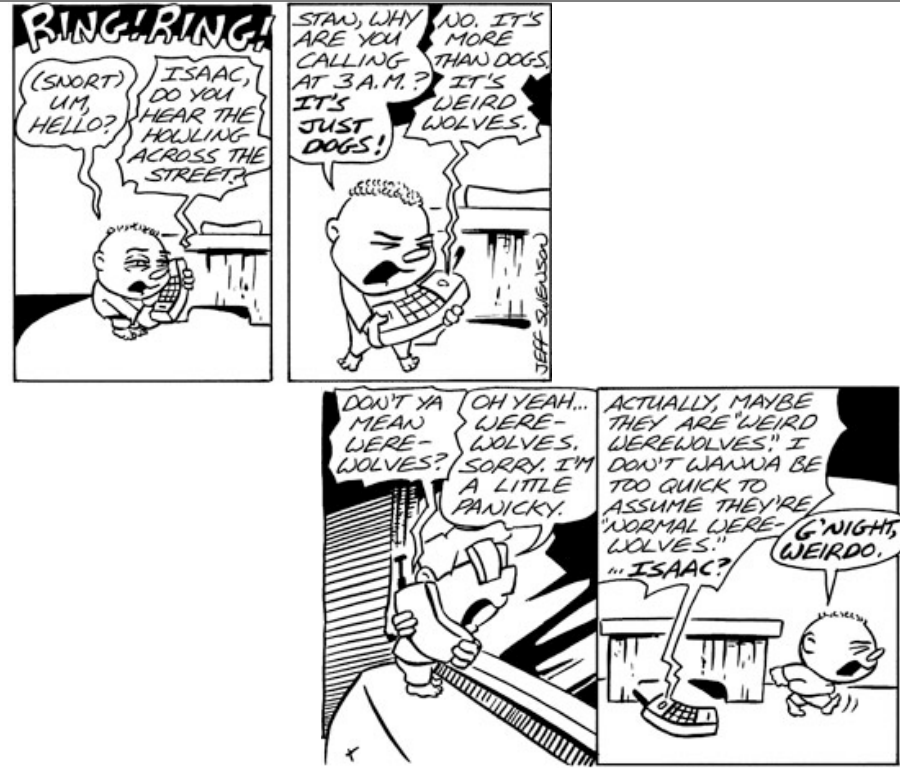

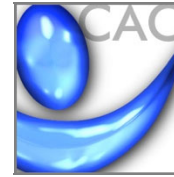

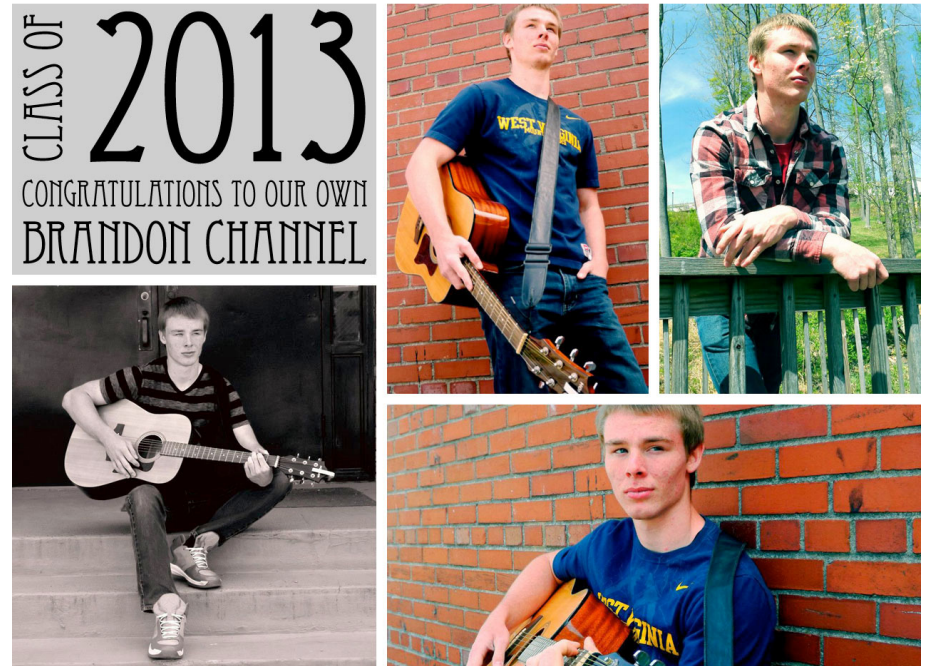
