### Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught on the baptism of the Holy Ghost, starting from Ezekiel 36:26 and including many other verses. The term Holy Ghost (Holy Spirit) refers to God in spiritual essence and action. Baptism means plunging or immersion. "Filling" is a complementary term that has several uses: 1. Initial baptism of the Holy Spirit (Acts 1:5, 2:4); 2. Empowerment, anointing, renewal (Acts 4:8, 4:31); and 3. Continual indwelling, spiritual walk (Eph. 5:18). The Spirit baptism is foretold in Old Testament prophecy (Joel 2:28-29; Jer. 31:31-33; Ezek 11:19, 36:26, 39:29). The Spirit baptism is a New Testament promise and command (Luke 3:16, 11:13, 24:49; John 3:5, 7:37-39, 14:26; Acts 1:4-5). We have a new experience under the new covenant, in which God takes away our stony heart and gives us a new heart. The Spirit baptism is part of salvation (John 3:3-5; Rom. 8:9-16; I Cor. 6:11, 12:13; Eph. 1:13-14; Titus 3:5). New Testament examples: Acts 2, 8, 9, 10, 19. Speaking in tongues is the initial sign (Acts 2:4, 10:45-46, 19:6; Isaiah 28:11-12; Mark 16:17). The Spirit baptism is received through repentance and faith.

### Sunday PM

Evangelist Reggie Bozeman preached "Hell's Favorite Word: Checkmate" from Exodus 4:1-4 & I Samuel 5:1-7. Carnal flesh is always looking for an artificial high, but there is nothing higher than the Most High. We insist on being more excited about Jesus than people are about football games. We cheer for Jesus, because He came to save us. When we send praises up, God sends glory down. Hell's favorite word may well be "checkmate." We sometimes get caught up in issues. Then the devil tells us we are in checkmate (finished), but he can't win. It's not checkmate! Our King has one more move! Hell lies and says our chains are here to stay, but our King steps in with another move. You are going to affect someone when you start praising God. Give God everything you have.

### Wednesday

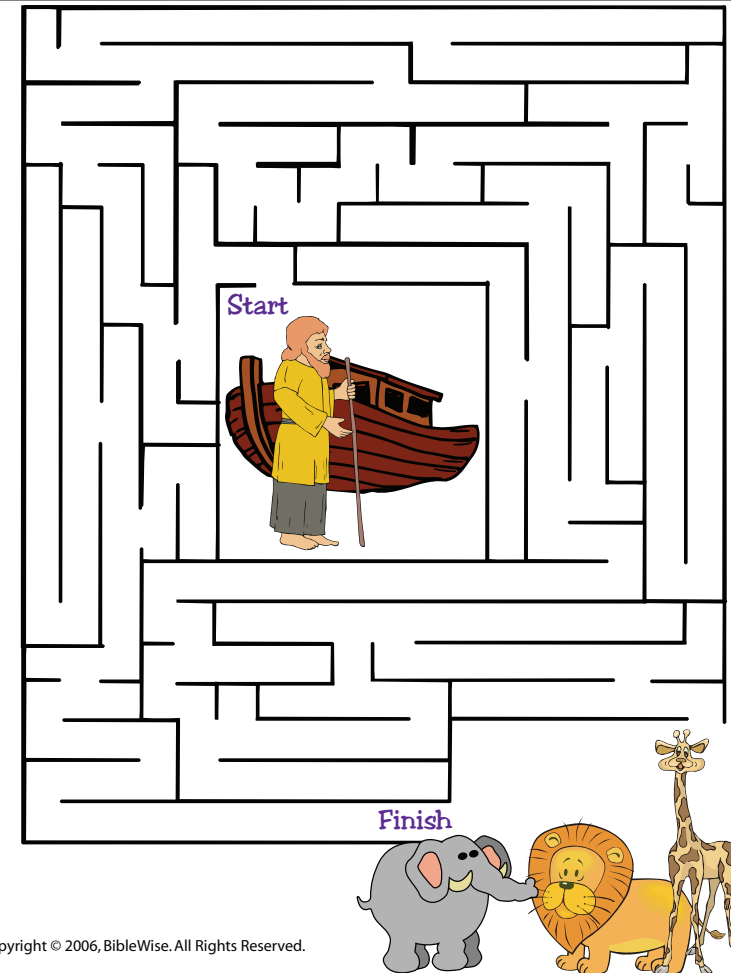

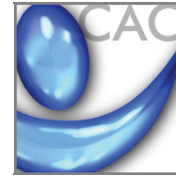
