

UPCI's General Superintendent, Rev David K. Bernard, reported, "NAYC had great worship, preaching, and prayer. My session for young & aspiring ministers was set up for 2,500, but we had to add 200 chairs!"

The mayor of Louisville met with them outside of the convention center to thank them for their service to the City of Louisville.
