Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "The Backside of the Testimony" from Revelation 12:11, 17 & Hebrews 10:23. The Bible is to be believed in its "plain sense" reading. At times it uses literal meaning, at times figurative, at times parables. Regardless, God intended for it to be understood and trusted as true. In the Book of Revelation the true Israel is figuratively represented as a woman clothed with the sun and having the moon at her feet. She has a crown with twelve stars, which typify the 12 tribes of Israel. This is an example of figurative language. The "true" Israel means those Jews who are truly serving God. Her offspring are "those who keep God's commands and hold fast their testimony about Jesus" (Rev. 12:17). The words "hold fast" are seen elsewhere: "Let us hold fast the profession of our faith without wavering" (Hebrews 10:23). The "powerful" testimony is more than just "God did this or that for me"; it is maintaining your declaration of faith in Jesus even while threatened with persecution or death. It is refusing to back down on your faith, even while under pressure! Even if the pressure is the prospect of death unless you recant about Jesus Christ! Every testimony has a backside (the pressure before the miracle or fulfillment comes). You have to suffer to have a victory. In the darkest of night when storms are so bad "hold fast" the profession of faith, your testimony about Jesus. When death seemed so "permanent" for Zach, then his family and church refused to blame God, or backslide, or to give in to depression or despair. When the misery and illness of Lupus seemed so "permanent" for Sis. McClain, she, her family and church refused to blame God, or backslide, or give in to depression or despair. We fulfilled the command to "hold fast" our profession of faith, our testimony about Jesus. The same is true about many more of us! We give praise to God in our storms and come out victorious. Hold fast! Keep believing!

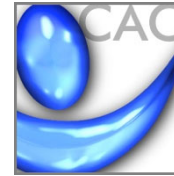
