The meaning of the name Judah is to use the hand, to revere or worship (with extended hands), to bemoan (by wringing the hands), cast (out), (make) confess (-ion), praise, (give) thank (-ful, -s, -sgiving). If you are called a praise-maniac, Praise God! We are to lift up holy hands unto the Lord and be thankful! When Judah went out to battle, they didn’t go out physical. They went into battle with praise and worship. When Jehoshaphat’s army entered singing God’s praises, the enemy was confused by the people’s spirit of praise in the midst of difficulty. Thus, Jehoshaphat’s army had victory. When you are in a spiritual warfare, pray and worship God. Don’t wring your hands and worry about a sickness, money or any trouble in your life.
