Pastor Joseph preached "The Eyes of Faith" from Numbers 13:26-33. Man's eyes and mind can fool him. We must trust in what God says. Some people put their trust in doctors more than in God. We must not do this. God can and may use a doctor to help, but we must keep our faith in God. If God promises you that something is going to happen, claim that promise. God told Moses to send twelve men to spy the land of Canaan, which the Lord had promised to the children of Israel. Two of the men looked through eyes of faith and saw victory. But ten of the men looked through eyes of flesh and saw defeat. Thus, they wandered through the wilderness for forty years. God took care of them, but a whole generation died, because they didn't believe the promise of God. Joshua and Caleb were the only ones who did not perish in the wilderness, and got to enter into the promised land. We must claim the promise that God has given us. Look through eyes of faith!

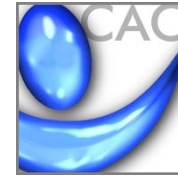
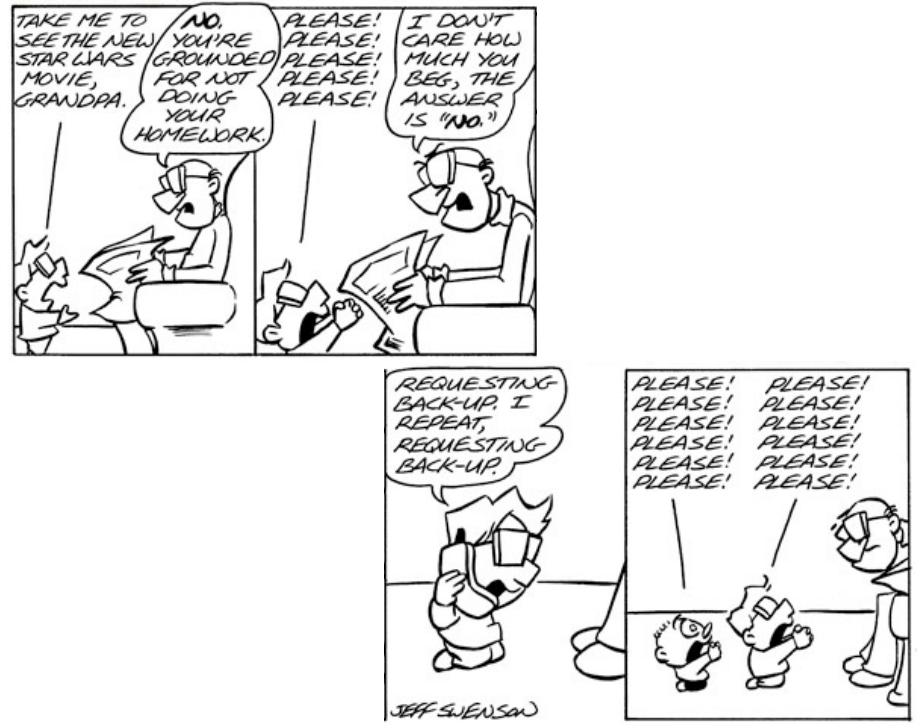
