## Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin and Pastor Joseph ministered by tag-team preaching. Elder Godwin preached "The Alabaster Box" from Luke 6:36-38. Just as the woman had to break the alabaster box before she anointed the feet of Jesus, we must be broken. We must break away from our desires and ambitions and be conformed to be like Him. The woman was moved by the awesomeness of Jesus, and she washed His feet so He could preach the gospel. Our mission is to tell others about Jesus. We must take this gospel to the streets. If we don't tell others about Jesus, they may never know. Pastor Joseph preached from II Timothy 3:1-16. We are living in a day when people call good evil and evil good. "Arise, shine; for thy light is come, and the glory of the Lord is risen upon thee" (Isaiah 60:1). Shine forth. Praise Him in the midst of a storm. No matter how great of a storm we are in we can have peace. The wall of salvation will protect us from any storm. Wherever Jesus is, there is power. There is victory in giving praise to God. In the midst of your problems and storms, stand and proclaim, "I will not give up. I will shine forth and praise God." The Lord will give us beauty for ashes, the oil of joy for mourning, and the garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness. We are not worthy to walk through the gates of Heaven, yet God will clothe us with a garment of His own righteousness. Praise and righteousness meet. If we truly love God, we will keep His commandments and sing forth His praise. *God will have praise!*

Rev. Terry Null preached "The Process of Transformation" from II Corinthians 12:5-9. We must continue to move forward. Even when things are not right, good can still come out of it. Although we have infirmities and problems, something greater is coming. We easily rejoice when everything is going well, but can we still take pleasure in our infirmities and problems, as Apostle Paul did? The Lord told Paul, "My grace is sufficient for thee: for my strength is made perfect in weakness." Thus Paul said "Most gladly therefore will I rather glory in my infirmities, that the power of Christ may rest upon me." Even if we must walk and worship alone, God will give us strength just as He did Elijah. He sends ravens to minister to us. Before you get to where God wants you to be, you must understand where you are now. In the midst of your troubles, God's Spirit is moving. When things look bad, good things can happen. God is going to take care of us.

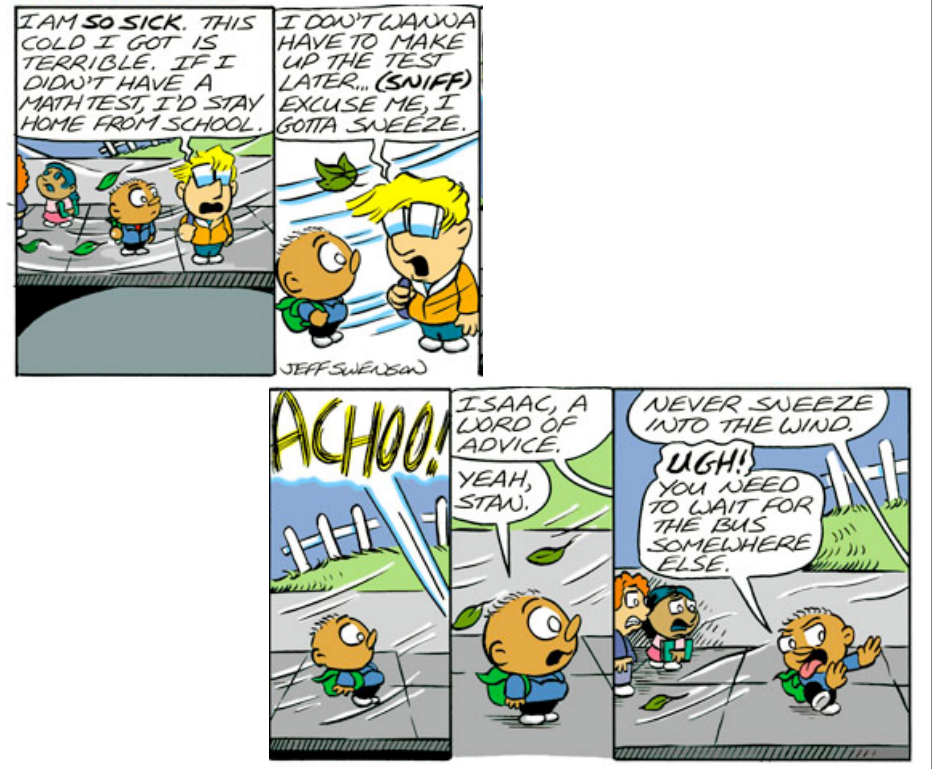

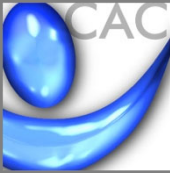

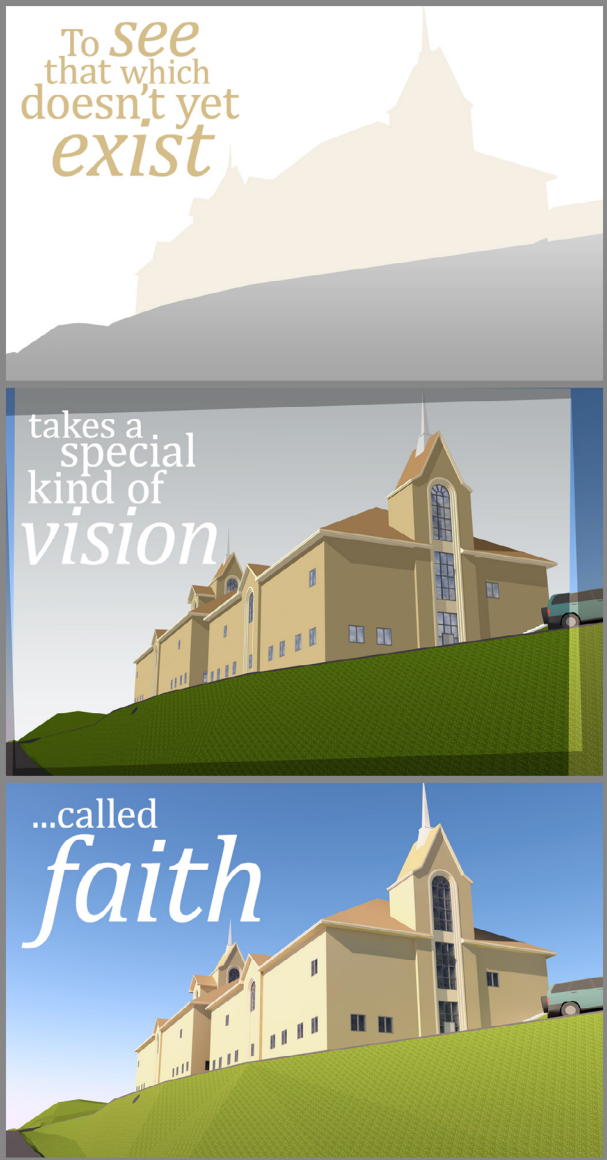
