## Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph began a series on how best to interpret Mosaic Law. What place should the Old Testament Law have in a New Testament believer's life? One often-used method is to classify each verse of the Law into one of three or so categories, such as civil, ceremonial, or moral, with the latter being "still to be obeyed." While that is safe with statements that are obviously moral, not all verses can be pigeonholed that way. Overall use of that over-simplified approach is arbitrary and leads to inconsistent decisions without basis in the text. A better approach: discern underlying principles in the important narratives in Scripture. By its very nature, the Mosaic Law was not to be, and could not be, obeyed to the letter by any people other than the Jews, in any other place as a rule of life. However, the Law has principles that are applicable and can bring blessing to all people anywhere and at any time when applied and used as a standard of right and wrong. God is holy, and also requires His people to be holy (see Lev. 20:7). One such principle is having a clear gender distinction in clothing (Deut. 22:5). We still obey this today. The world's cultures have perverted gender distinction and removed modesty. People err by following their heart (Jeremiah 17:9). Follow godly principles. The Old Testament is a schoolmaster leading to Christ.

## Sunday PM

Missionary Steve Bennett preached "Getting Beyond Fear" from Luke 21:7-20, 28. We are living in perilous times. The enemy is using fear to destroy everything that is of a good report and pure. We must focus on Jesus for in Him is no fear. We must witness to souls. Trust in God and conquer your fears. Don't fear what man can do to you. When you're in troublesome times, don't let fear get you down. Hold your head up and walk in faith. We must be wise as serpents and harmless as doves. Lay aside fears and doubts and look at what lies ahead without fear. What lies beyond fear? Faith, victory and revival. God is love. "There is no fear in love; but perfect love casteth out fear; because fear hath torment. He that feareth is not made perfect in love" (I John 4:18).

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "I'm Holding On" from Genesis 32:24-26. Just as Jacob held onto the angel until he was blessed we must keep holding onto Jesus. The lady with the issue of blood never gave up. Through troubles and trials—regardless of the situation—keep holding onto Jesus with faith. Keep holding onto what you've been taught. Stay close to Jesus. Don't distance yourself. Everything you need is in Jesus.  
Elder Charles Hoskins preached on passing the test of faith, from Genesis 22:1-12. God will take us places to prove and test us just as He did when He told Abraham to sacrifice his son. When we are tested, we need to worship Him. We must be obedient to God and walk by faith. Abraham saw Jesus' day and was glad. We must look for the things that are unseen. Keep your eyes on things eternal.

"Wouldn't you know it," Johnny fumed, "the one time I don't go and He shows up."

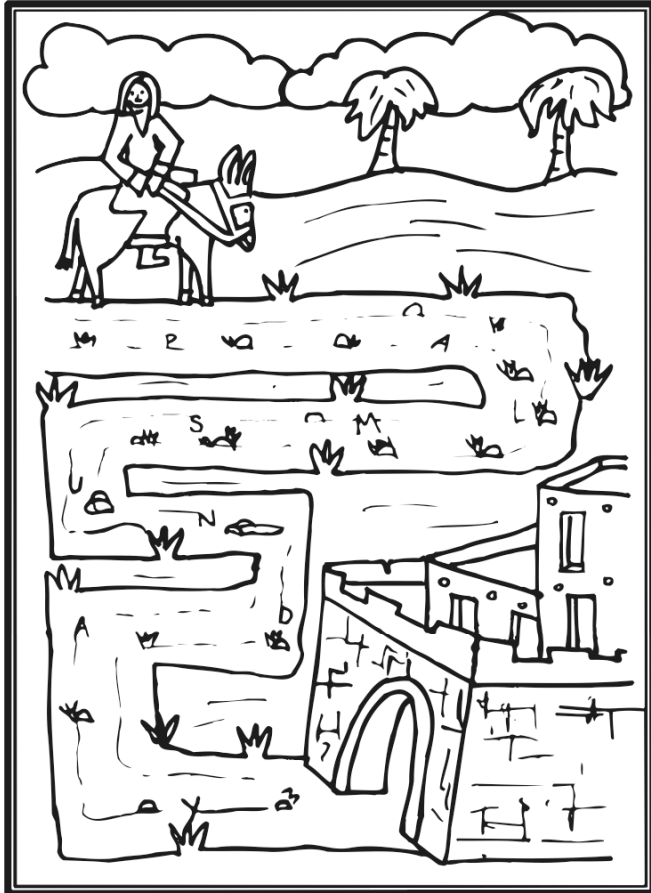

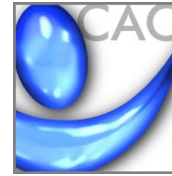
**Fun!** Kids Corner **Jesus' Triumphant Entry into Jerusalem**

What is this Sunday called? Find the letters in the road and place the letters in the blanks below to form the answer.



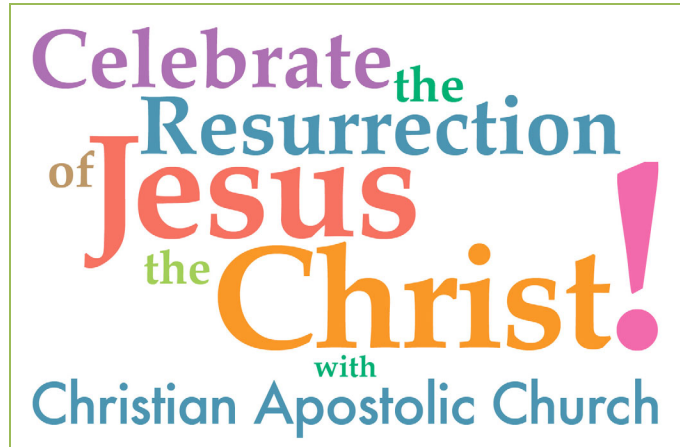
