Pentecost Sunday AM

Missionary Daniel Rushing preached "It's Time to Claim Your Jubilee" from Leviticus 25:8-13. The Year of Jubilee is a time of freedom and celebration when everyone will receive back their original property, and slaves are freed and return home to their families. Jesus Christ shed His blood on Calvary's cross so that man can be set free. He paid the price for our sins. In Jesus' early ministry He went into the synagogue on the Sabbath day and stood up to read. "And there was given Him the book of the prophet Isaiah.... 'The Spirit of the Lord is upon Me; for this reason, He has anointed Me to preach the gospel to the poor; He has sent Me to heal those who are brokenhearted, to proclaim pardon to the captives and recovery of sight to the blind, to send forth in deliverance those who have been crushed, To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord'" (Luke 4:17-19). Jesus was quoting there from Isaiah 61, verses 1 & 2. We know that "the wages of sin is death; but the gift of God is eternal life through Jesus Christ our Lord" (Romans 6:23). It's time to claim your Jubilee. Come unto Him and get His blood applied to your life. He will set you free.

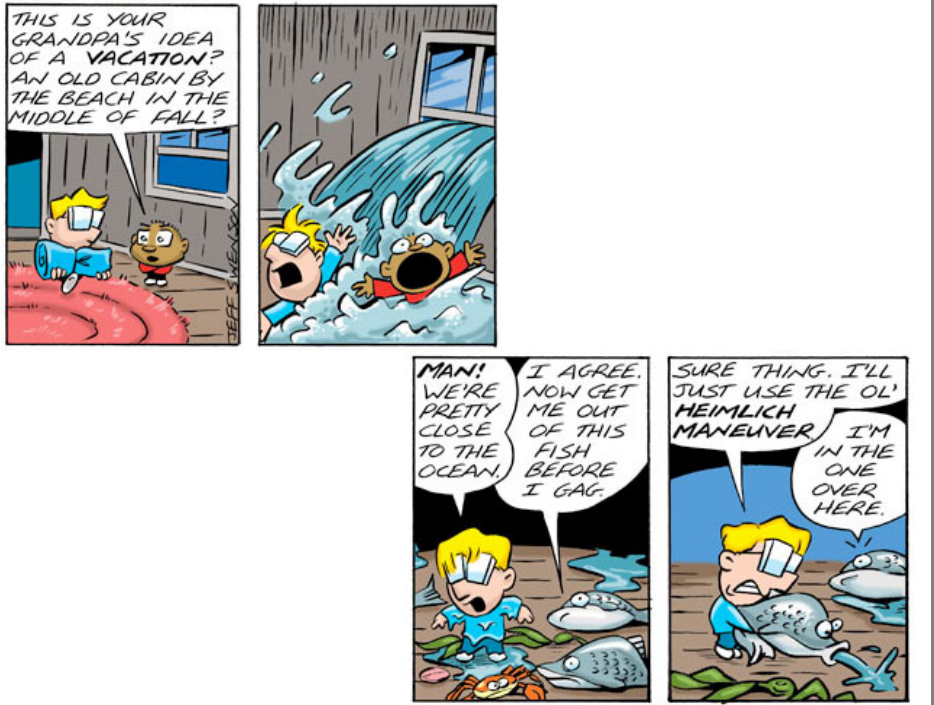

Penny Trick

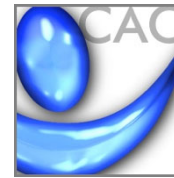
