Pastor Joseph preached "Better Than My Fathers?" from II Kings 21:19-23 & I Kings 19:1-4. God doesn't hold fathers accountable for the sins of their children nor does he hold children accountable for the sins of their fathers. "The soul that sins shall die." However, children do suffer some consequences of their parents' sins. Nevertheless, every person is guilty only according to his own sins. God is longsuffering and full of great mercy. Elijah fell into despair and fled after Jezebel sent him a message saying he would be killed. Yet he was able to rise up out of this depression when God came to visit him. Men too often see themselves as inadequate and say "I can't take it anymore." A better approach would be to give thanks to God that "you're still here" and realize that with God's help you can rise up and have victory. If your forefathers were wicked, make up your mind, "I will not walk in the sinful paths of my fathers." You can be better than your fathers.

Pastor David Johnston preached "The Lord Has Turned the Light On His Church" from Isaiah 60:1-3. God is in control even in the midst of all the world's problems. He is greater than any problem. We have an unshakeable foundation. We are founded on the Rock, Jesus Christ. He is our refuge and strength. It's time for us to rise and shine! God has faith and confidence in us to live in this generation. The world may be getting dark but God is putting His spotlight on the Church. Be a reflection of His glory! People are watching us. Fill in the boxes below the picture, using the first letter of each object above the box. When you are finished, you will have written an important Bible verse.

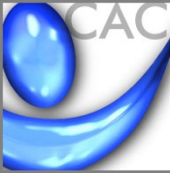
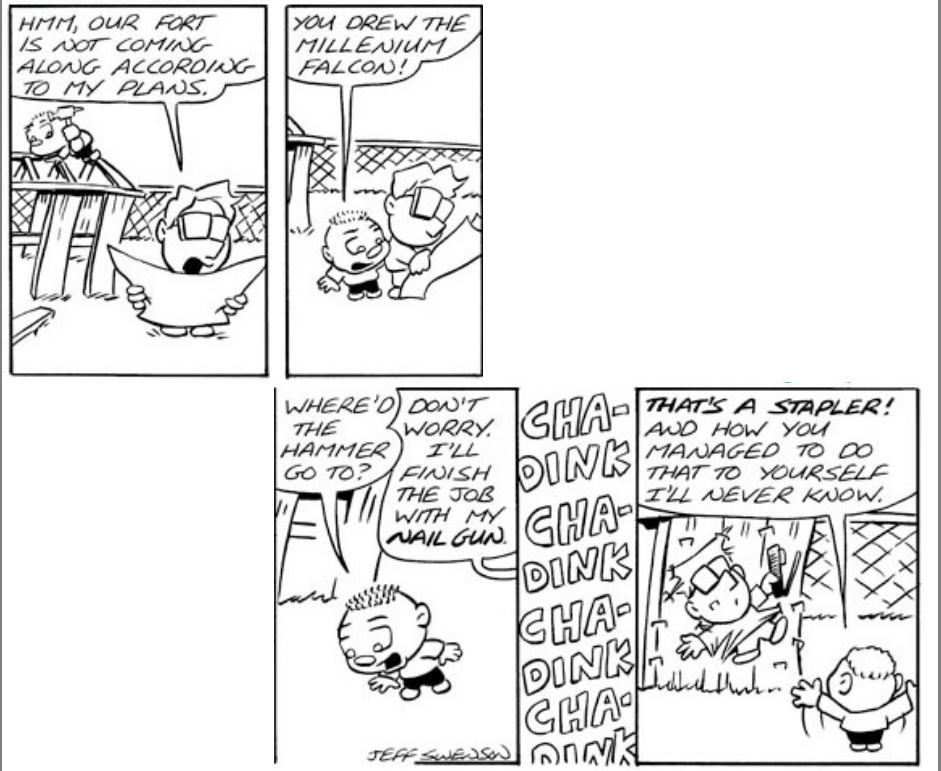
