Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "In The Smoke" from Psalm 119:83 & Luke 5:36-39. In Bible days, unfermented grape juice was stored in wineskins—bottles made of animal skin instead of glass. People placed sealed wineskins in heat (and thus in smoke), to increase the rate of fermentation. If new wine were placed in an old wineskin, then as the juice fermented and the pressure rose, the brittle, inflexible wineskin would fail to expand as the chemical reaction occurred. Consequently the skin would burst, wasting the juice. Wine is a symbol of God's Spirit. Heat represents our trials that cause us to mature more quickly. We must stay renewed in God's Spirit in order to take the heat. In Christ you are a new creature. Continually let God quicken you in Him. We all have trials, but it's how we respond to the trial that matters. God will give us strength to endure. During times when we feel like we are "in the smoke," we must remain faithful. When in the smoke pray, "Lord, quicken me." Our precepts are flawed, but His are right. We must die out to sin. Let His mind be in you.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Christ The Rock" from Matt. 16:13-19 & I Cor. 10:1-6. Jesus went into Jewish cities & synagogues, preaching and healing the sick. People were astonished at His doctrine. When John the Baptist was in prison, he pondered and sent men to ask Jesus if He really was the one. He told them to go tell John the things they had seen and heard. "The blind receive their sight, and the lame walk, the lepers are cleansed, and the deaf hear, the dead are raised up, and the poor have the gospel preached to them" (Matt. 11:5). Jesus is the Messiah—the Anointed One. Jesus asked the disciples, "Whom say ye that I am? And Simon Peter answered and said, Thou art the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Matt. 16:15-16). Jesus told Peter that He was going to build His church upon the rock. **Jesus is the Rock.** Jesus said, "I and my father are one" (John 10:30). God said, "I, even, I, am the Lord; and beside me there is no saviour" (Isaiah 43:11). Jesus said "Come unto me, all ye that labour and are heavy laden, and I will give you rest" (Matt. 11:28). Who is Jesus to you? Do you accept Him as the Messiah?

Wednesday

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "I'm Unshakable" from Psalm 125:1-5. They who trust in the Lord shall not be removed. Have your heart and mind set that you will be unshakable and will remain in the house of the Lord. David was not shaken when he stood before (9 feet tall) Goliath. We need to have faith like David. Have faith in Jesus Christ. No matter what happens we must not compromise on God's Word. Be like a tree planted by the water – unmovable.

Elder Hoskins preached "Hear The Word of The Lord and Be Healed" from Revelation 3:20. Jesus is knocking at our heart's door. We need to hear what He says to us and have fellowship with Him. If you open the door Jesus will come in. Be desperate and do all you can to get to Jesus. Let's make our hearts open to hear the word of faith. It's important to hear the preaching of God's Word.
