## Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Born From Above" from John 3:1-8. Some translations of the Bible render the words "born again" as "born from above." Jesus called the disciples and told them to follow Him and He would make them fishers of men. The way they traditional fished was to drop a net on the fish from above. When the Lord "captures" us for His kingdom, we are like fish caught in a glorious net of righteousness thrown upon us from above! The power from above comes on us as the Holy Ghost comes, and is a result of the Spirit baptism. This which was poured out from above at Pentecost caused them to speak with tongues. God requires that we submit to being "captured from above" to being "controlled, compelled, constrained, apprehended" from above. We must be willing to surrender control to Him in order to be born from above. No man can tame his own tongue so we need God's help in keeping our carnal nature in check. We must fully surrender our life to God. "Whosoever is born of God doth not commit sin" (I John 3:9).

## Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Walk By Faith, Not By Sight" from II Corinthians 5:7, John 20:29 & I Peter 1:8. All true believers who are serving God faithfully on the earth are, in fact, "walking by faith"—meaning we are serving God without getting to see the Lord's face yet. We are serving in the "by faith" realm. Only when we have passed to the other side where we will see the Lord face to face will we be in the "by sight" realm. Paul was stating that we who serve God in a natural body here are not present with the Lord spatially (physically) in heaven, thus we are walking in a "by faith" realm and not a "by sight" realm. If you have been born again by birth of water (baptism in water in Jesus name) and birth of the Spirit (baptism of the Holy Ghost) and you are serving God on earth, then you *are* walking by faith, because you are not with the Lord in heaven, so you are not walking by sight. We as believers are permitted to fellowship with God in a "by faith" realm, although we don't deserve it. Paying attention to what we have, and enjoying God's presence now, serves to get us ready to enjoy His presence later in the "by sight" realm in the hereafter.

## Wednesday

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "Who Shall Separate Us?" from Romans 8:35-39. Nothing can force us out of God's hand, but we may indeed walk out on our own. We must be very careful not to let things in this life move us to separate ourselves from God. It's a very dangerous to do our own thing. Samson thought he knew what he was doing. We must pray and seek God's face for direction when we get married, get a job, and in every aspect of our life. We must live separate from this world.

Elder Les Benedum exhorted the church to be concerned for people's souls. People can feel our spirit. What do they feel when they come to church here? We need to pray for the youth. The world will always pull against the church. But greater is He that is in us than he that is in the world.

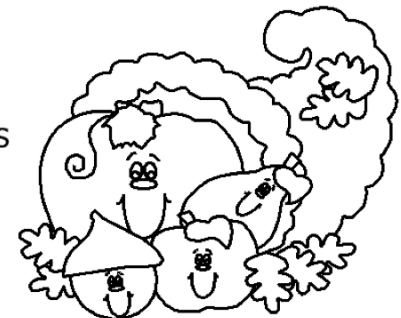

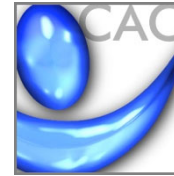
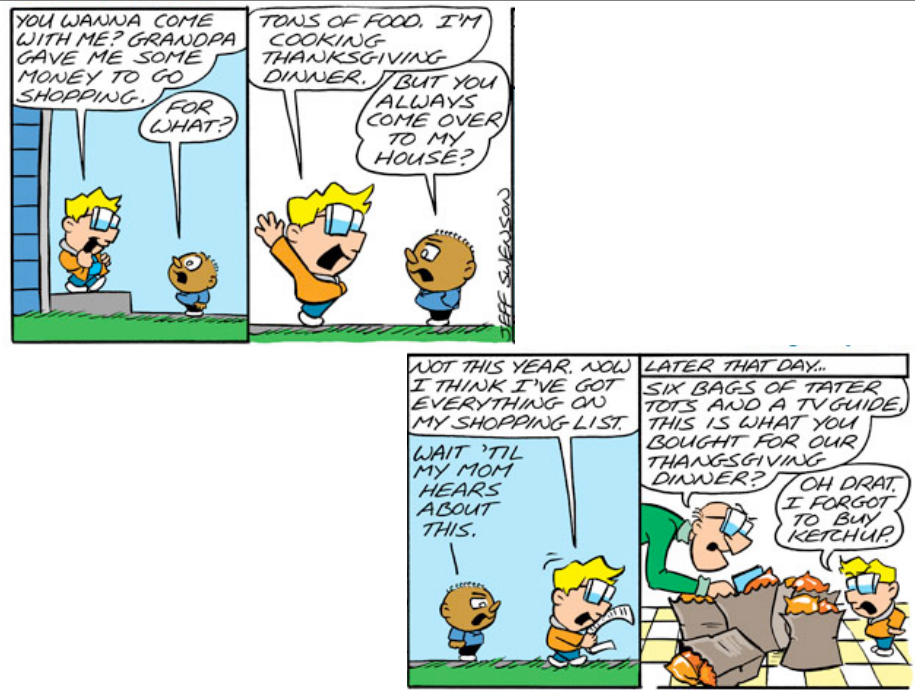
