Sunday AM

Elder Lorren God preached about one's relationship with God from Matthew 4:18-22. When Jesus called His early disciples to follow Him, they straightway (immediately) left their nets and followed Him. They knew they had met the "pearl of great price." Later, when the multitude turned away from Jesus because of His straight teaching, He asked the few remaining early disciples if they would also leave Him. Peter answered, "Lord to whom shall we go? Thou hast the words of eternal life" (John 6:68). A believer's relationship with Jesus is something beautiful and precious. When Jesus was twelve years old and His parents unknowingly left Him behind in Jerusalem, they returned and searched until they found Him. We need to search after God with our whole heart. We need to intensively and diligently search after Him. Make up your mind that you will do whatever it takes to maintain a close relationship with God. Attend prayer meetings. Praise and worship Him. Hear the preaching of God's Word. We must desperately seek Him. Have clear communication and total dedication to Him.

Pastor Joseph preached "The Kingdom of Heaven" from Daniel 2:44, Matthew 19:13-24 & John 3:1-10. "Kingdom of Heaven" is synonymous with "Kingdom of God." His authority over heaven and earth is due to the fact that He created heaven and earth. He is the only wise King with dominion over all. God can and does intervene in the affairs of mankind, including setting up rulers and taking rulers down. He has all power. We need to live our lives in submission to the King of Kings and Lord of Lords. The Bible foretells a 7-year period of great tribulation coming upon the earth in these last days, but the Church will be protected from the wrath of God, apparently by the Rapture. Jesus taught that for you to enter into the kingdom of God you must be born of water and of the Spirit. The apostles, who had their understanding opened by Jesus, knew this to refer to water baptism in Jesus name and the baptism of the Holy Ghost. When you receive the Holy Ghost, there will be a sound: "**thou hearest the sound thereof...so is every one that is born of the Spirit**" (John 3:8). On the Day of Pentecost, they spoke with tongues when the Holy Ghost was poured upon them. We must die out to this world and keep the commandments of God. Then, we are in the Kingdom of Heaven/God.

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Elephants Don't Bite" from the Song of Solomon 2:15. Instead of thinking that we are entitled of the blessings we get, we need to appreciate and be thanking God for what we have. We should never be unthankful. Trouble will come—life is life. Don't let it get you down. Think of all the good things God has done for you. "But godliness with contentment is great gain" (I Timothy 6:6). We must have a grateful attitude, a mindset of thankfulness and contentment.

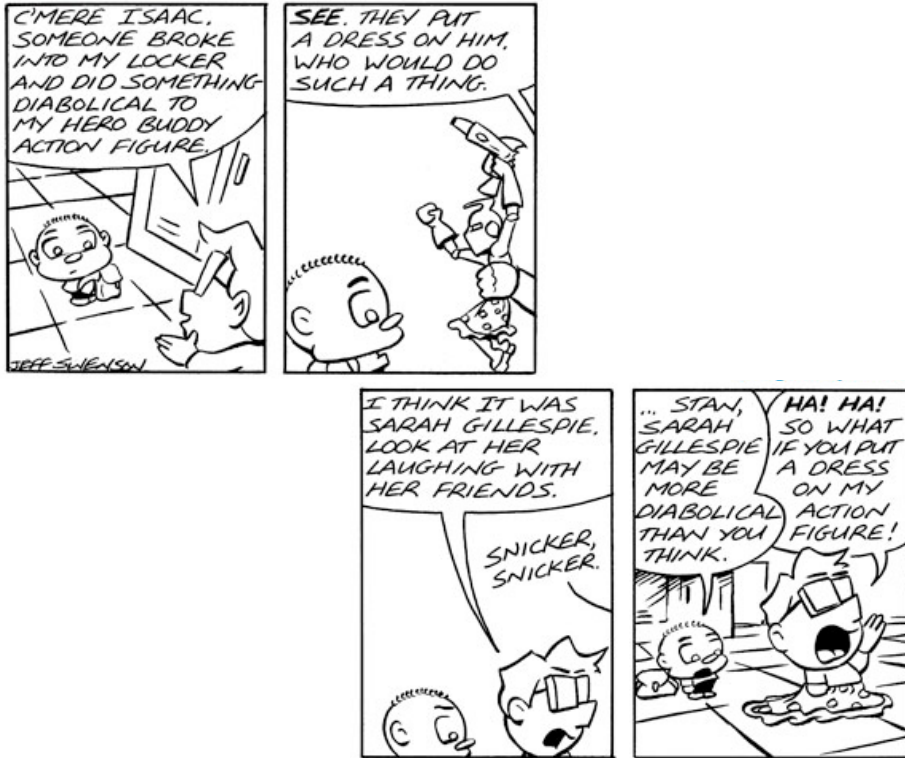

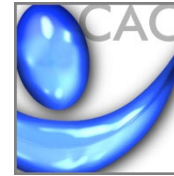
