Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Almighty Savior" from John 12:1-11. Jesus is the Almighty Savior. Jesus didn't go to Lazarus as soon as He learned that he was sick. He wanted to show them that He is more than the Healer. He is the Resurrection! Caiaphas, high priest when Jesus was crucified, prophesied that Jesus would die for that nation. The Jewish religious leaders sought to kill Lazarus because his miraculous testimony was causing many Jews believe in Jesus (which the leaders saw as a threat to their power). Why did they think that would work? Jesus could just raise him up again! They couldn't get rid of Jesus by killing Him. He just came back to life again! He is the Resurrection! He is the Almighty God! This world will laugh at us, try to silence us, try to kill us, try to discredit our witness, but God is on our side. We are in a relationship with the Resurrection and the Life! He is our Almighty Savior!

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "Spiritual Warfare" from Isaiah 17-24 & Revelation 12:7-11. We are in a spiritual warfare. We are instruments God can use in battle if we have been baptized In Jesus name, filled with the Holy Ghost, and if we are obedient to God's law. Because God knows the outcome, He doesn't always give us what we ask. We must put our trust in God. He knows what's best for us. Be obedient to God's law. We can win in this spiritual warfare if we have favor with God. Don't turn your back on God if He tells you "no." Joshua told the Children of Israel "choose you **this day** whom ye will serve" (Joshua 24:15). Today is the only day we have. Yesterday is past and tomorrow is in the future. Spirit warfare is about decisions. God knows our present, past and future. He is in control. This world is temporary. Heaven is eternal.

Elder Zach Sandy preached "Faith Overcomes Fear" from Deuteronomy 31:6. Faith protects us from fear. The small battles we go through in life prepare us for bigger ones. We must delight in God's Word – hide it in our heart – meditate upon it day and night. Be in subjection to our pastor – pray for him. We must put God first in our lives. Give Him full access to our life.
