### Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached “God Is...” from I Kings 20:28. Trials and storms do not change God. He’s the same, yesterday, today and forever. God is God, and God won’t ever change. Situations may arise in our lives, but God is still God. He is in control. We all will have sicknesses, problems, temptations and trials. But we must still serve God. We don’t have time to stop and have a “pity party,” as Elijah did. We must go forward and proclaim to the world that God is God. Blessed be the name of the Lord! 
