
Wednesday

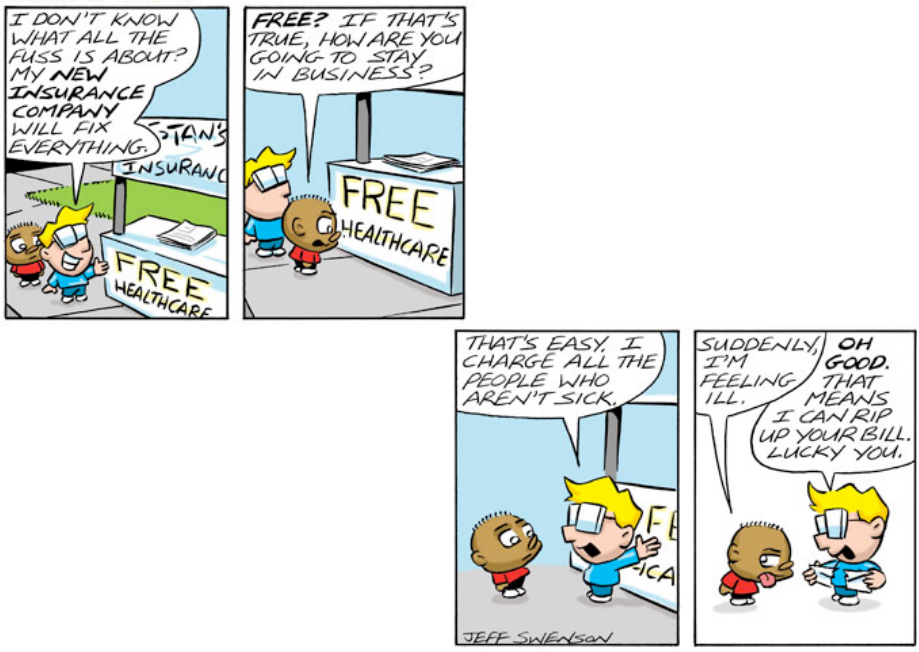

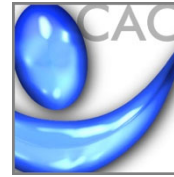
