## Sunday AM

Elder Lorren Godwin preached "This Time, It's Different" from II Chronicles 32:10-14, 20-21. The devil will try to destroy us. He has many tricks. If we give in and listen to him, we will be defeated. Do not enter a battle with a defeated mindset. Know that God is greater than the situation and will give you victory. Don't be afraid of the devil. God has given us power "over all the power of the enemy" (Luke 10:19). When you're in a battle, whether physical or spiritual, pray and turn it over to Jesus. 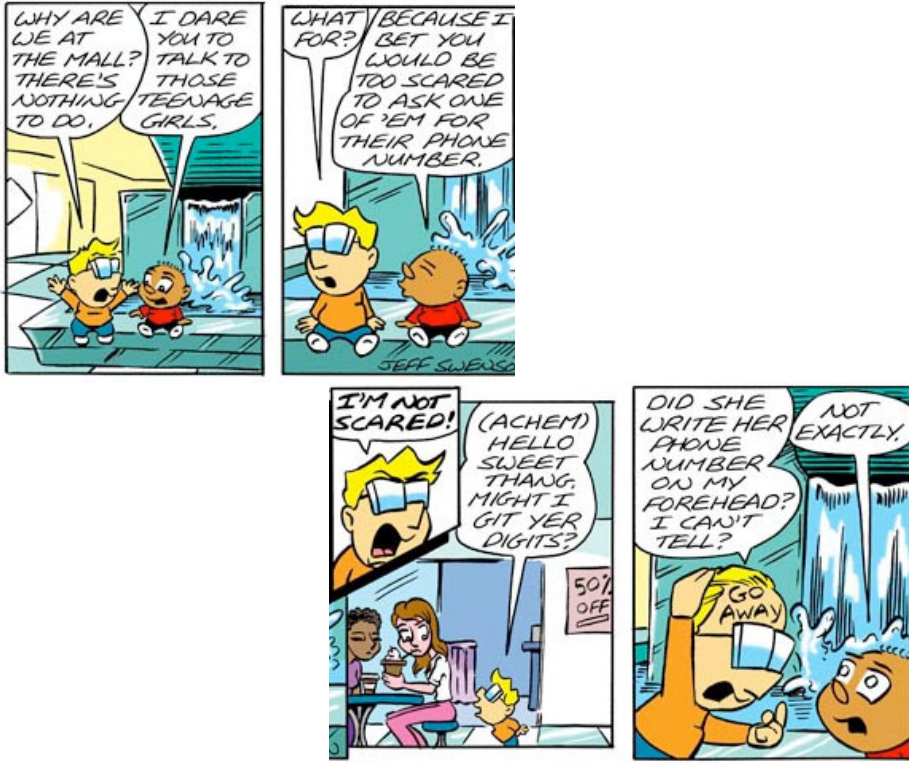

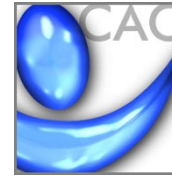

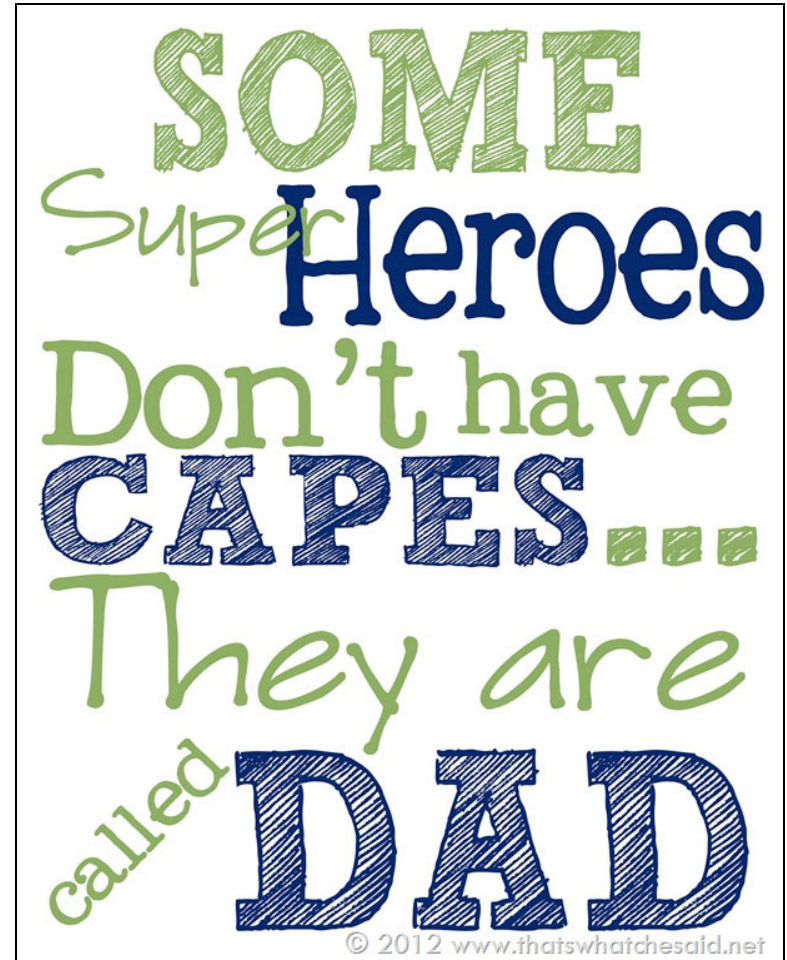
