Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph preached "Mankind" from Mark 3:1-6. This passage describes a nameless man known only for his handicap. In the beginning, God created various kinds of creatures, finally including the human kind, often called mankind, which includes all races of humans. Races are simply "people groups." According to the dictionary, factors that can distinguish people groups may include several things beside just the shade of skin. For example, language, religion, nationality, region, etc, are all factors that can make a people group distinct. Biblical words for such people groups include descriptions such as those found in Revelation 7:9 (emphasis added) "After this I beheld, and, lo, a great multitude, which no man could number, of all nations, and kindreds, and people, and tongues, stood before the throne, and before the Lamb, clothed with white robes...." No people of any one race should think of themselves as superior to other races. God has made every man to be specific in his own way. We should look beyond our differences and see all others as fellow humans. We must look past our own problems and see the needs of others. Always be ready to lend a helping hand. Be wary of things that offend you in the church. Humans have a tendency to exaggerate differences and to view others as an enemy when they are not. You are no better than another person just because they are different in skin tone or language or culture. We should not demonize or hate an entire race or group of people.
