Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Joseph's Three Betrayals" from Genesis 37:23-24. Although Joseph was betrayed (1) by his brothers, (2) by Potiphar's wife, and (3) by the butler, he kept his eyes fixed upon God. Nothing stopped him from serving God. We may be betrayed by our brothers/sisters in the church. Sometimes God will put someone ungodly in our path who will try to turn us against our leadership as Potiphar's wife did to Joseph. He was betrayed when the butler forgot about him after being released. Sometimes God will allow betrayals to happen in order to bless and keep us in a way we don't understand. Joseph was released at the proper time to be used by God to save all of Egypt. Sometimes life keeps throwing problems at us. We may wonder, "Why is this happening?" and "Will I ever see daylight again?" Keep your mind and thoughts pure; keep your eyes on Jesus. Stay true to God, and He will reward you.

Pastor Joseph preached "Time To Speak" from Ecclesiastes 3:1-8, Isaiah 62:1 & John 5:28-29. We must warn others, letting know of God's truth and His coming judgment for sin. This is not the time to be silent! It is time to speak up. There are forces of spiritual wickedness that are actively trying to undermine God's authority and His plan for mankind, through such tricks as blurring gender distinction by mixture of men/women's clothing, attacking gender, and attacking marriage. There are individual people, groups, governments and other parties trying to get people to boycott Israel, companies to divest from Israel, and governments to sanction Israel. Marriage is under threat of being "re-defined." We need to speak out against these ungodly things. We must "speak the truth in love." On Mars Hill (Acts 17) Paul the Apostle spoke boldly the word of God to the people who worshipped an unknown god. We need to stand up for the truth. The time is now!

Elder Rusty Sandy preached "What Are You Sacrificing?" from Genesis 4:3-5. We live in a world where everyone wants to give up "just enough" to feel holy. 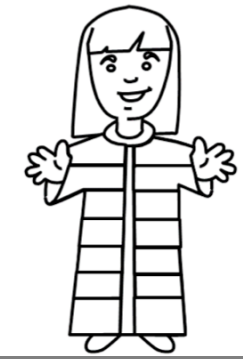

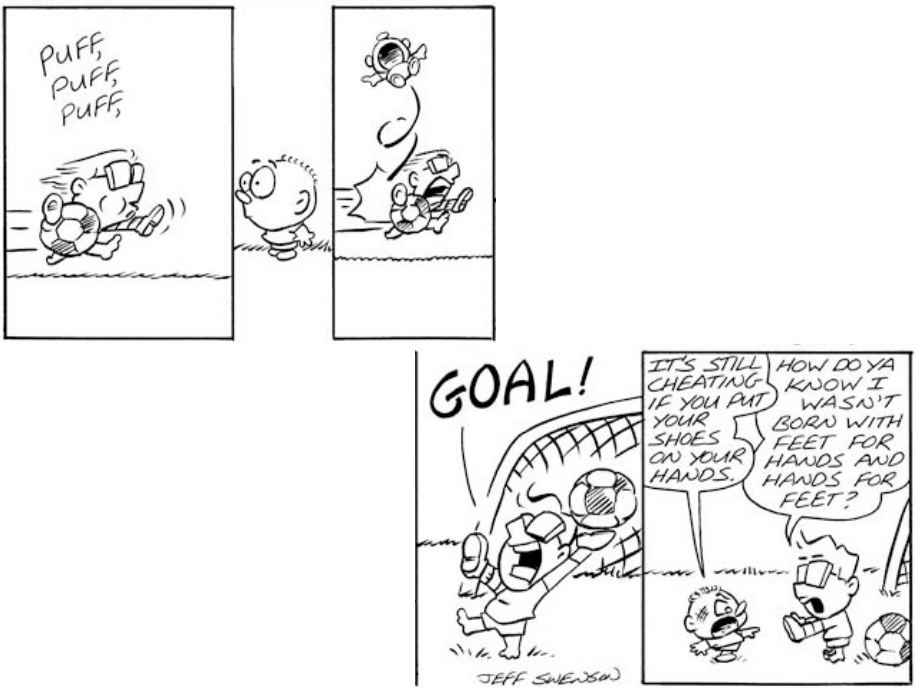

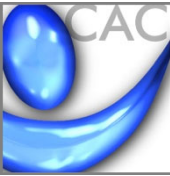
