Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph taught on the Book of Revelation using Revelation 1:1, 10-11, 19, 20. The primary "Revelation" is the unveiling of Jesus Christ. The book includes an admonition to repent. It is apocalyptic (i.e. referring to the "end time") and prophetic in nature. The author, the apostle John, saw One sitting on the throne in Heaven: Jesus, who is the fullness of God manifest in flesh. Jesus told Philip, "If you've seen me, you've seen the Father" (John 14:9). It pleased the Father to have all His fulness dwell in the Son (Colossians 1:19). Some believe the Rapture will take place before the Great Tribulation, some during it, and some afterward. More important than "when" is that we be ready when the trumpet sounds. Whatever happens on this earth, we must stand for God and stand for truth. One day all will stand before the man, Jesus, to be judged. He has been given authority to execute judgment (John 5:27). The First Resurrection seems to happen in installments, including Old Testament saints (Matt. 27:52), then Church Age saints (1 Cor. 15:52), and then martyred Tribulation saints (Revelation 20:4-6). To be ready—having our name in the Lamb's Book of Life is the heart cry of every true believer.

Sunday PM

Pastor Joseph preached "He Brought Me Out!" from Psalm 40:11 & 27:1-6, 14. God is able to bring us out. He is "able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think" (Ephesians 3:20). We don't deserve God's blessings. We can't earn salvation. Yet He gives to us freely. "For I know the thoughts that I think toward you, saith the Lord, thoughts of peace, and not of evil, to give you an expected end" (Jeremiah 29:11). God is not looking for an excuse to destroy us. He is willing to help us as long as we repent, no matter how many wrong turns we make. He can bring us out of the pit. He can bring us out of addiction. His commands are not grievous. They are not meant to make things hard for us. They are meant to guide our steps. He will make our steps secure. Oh, how He loves us!

Elder Hannah Sandy preached "What More Could Have Been Done?" from Isaiah 5:1-4. God is so good to us. He has given us nourishment and protection. He doesn't do things half way. He never makes mistakes. So, why do we sin? Why aren't we producing fruit? What more could He have done for you? Search your hearts. God has given us all we need. Are we giving all to Him?
Elder Baron Claypool preached "Who's Your Daddy?" from Deuteronomy 23:2 & I Peter 2:6-10. We who have repented, been baptized in Jesus' name, and received the Holy Ghost are children of the one, true God (and as long we are living a holy life, we as children are pleasing to Him.) When we are baptized in Jesus' name, His blood is applied to our lives, and with the Holy Ghost baptism we belong to Him (Romans 8:9). This makes Him our Daddy! God has our best interests in mind, just as an earthly daddy has for his children. God desires to bring peace, joy and victory to our lives.

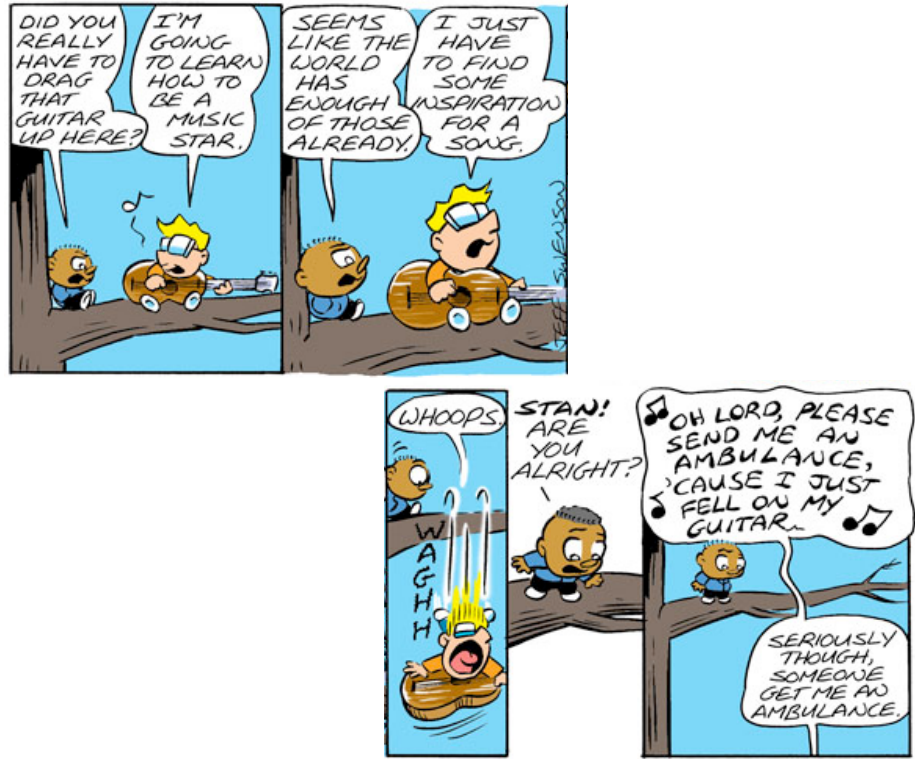

Hot Sauce

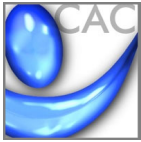
