Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Staying Once The Crowd Leaves" from John 20:1-14. Our society is impatient. We don't want to wait on anything, including God. Many times when we pray and don't immediately feel God's presence we quit instead of pushing through. When the disciples saw Jesus' burial wrappings in the tomb, they immediately left. However, Mary Magdalene stayed. Because she waited, she was rewarded in getting to see Jesus. When we pray for God to take care of our need we must be patient and persevere. Continue to pray and seek His face. God always comes through and answers prayer. His time is not our time. We can't get satisfied with what happened yesterday, we must press forward. God will do great things for us if we wait upon Him. "But they that wait upon the Lord shall renew their strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; and they shall walk, and not faint" (Isaiah 40:31). If you are patient with God, He will be faithful to you.

Pastor Joseph preached "Spiritual Authority" from I Corinthians 12:28 & Hebrews 13:17. It behooves all believers to remember that a good pastor is a "man of God." We must remember that he is a "man" who can make mistakes, but also realize he is "of God"—his office calls for respect due to spiritual authority. Our pastor must one day give an account of each one of us to God, and it is not profitable for us if that account has to be painful. We should be careful so the account of us may be given with joy. We must be sensitive to the Spirit—both directly, and through the voice of our pastor. When God called to Samuel, His voice sounded like the voice of Eli, Samuel's "pastor." Our leaders shouldn't have to cajole us into worship for God or manipulate us to live holy. We should worship and live holy as we follow the godly example of our leaders. We are blessed to have leadership ordained of God. Spiritual leaders must learn the word of God. Elders must "feed the flock of God." They must study and know God's Word, and to then preach the truth. We must respect and obey the spiritual authority of our pastor.

ACA also utilizes Accelerated Christian Education's LCA program (a cooperative dual-enrollment plan), which means that our ACA-LCA graduates obtain a diploma that has full accreditation with the Commission on International and Trans-Regional Accreditation and the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools. Yearly, many ACA students score so well on the Stanford Achievement Test (SAT), they "max out" and are rated PHS—"post high school."

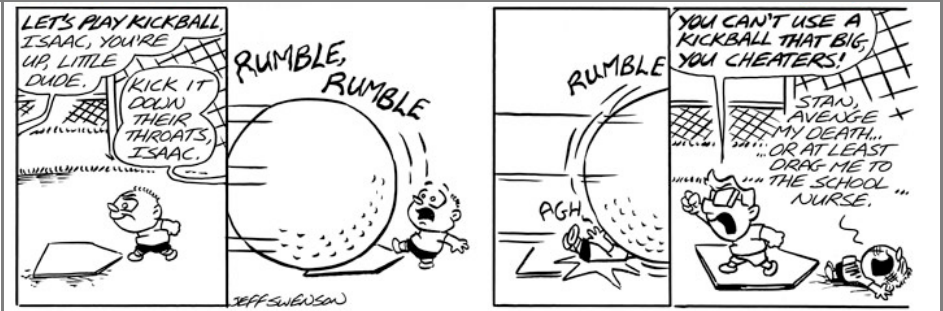

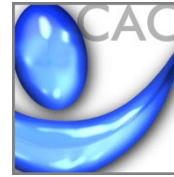
