Elder Lorren Godwin preached "In Pursuit Of Righteousness" from Psalm 139:8. Olympic athletes have a goal of participating in the Olympics. We must have a goal of pursuing Jesus/pursuing righteousness. Our life must be consumed with Jesus Christ. We must strive everyday to be more like Him. The pursuit of righteousness should be our goal in the good times and in the bad times. After Jacob met God personally he was a changed person. We must know Him personally. There must come a point in everyone's life when he meets God for himself and makes a personal commitment to Him. We must focus solely on him. "And ye shall seek me, and find me, when ye shall search for me with all your heart" (Jeremiah 29:13). It is commitment when you don't feel like praying and you do it anyhow. It is commitment when you push through difficult times. Make a commitment in the pursuit of righteousness.

Pastor Joseph preached "Light of the World" from Isaiah 49:6 and Matthew 5:14 (and other verses). Christians cite Jesus' command for us to be the light of the world, yet often fail to realize the Israelites were so appointed by God, hundreds of years before Gentile believers in Messiah were afforded a chance to join in. Major ways that Israel has been a light to the nations include being those through whom came the Word of God (the Bible) and through whom came the Messiah. "Replacement Theology" is a false doctrine. We don't "replace" Israel as the light to the nations; we join in. We don't shine by cutting off our roots, but by being grafted in (connected) to our Jewish roots. To shine, we are blessed with Service Gifts (Romans 12:4-8), Spiritual Gifts (I Cor. 12:4-11), and Equipping Gifts (Ephesians 4:11-13).

Wednesday

Elder Kieran Joseph spoke on our need to sow the seed in witnessing, using Matt. 13 (Parable of the Sower). He testified of his Apostolic Youth Corp mission trip to Oahu, Hawaii. The AYC team went door-to-door, held street meetings, and did church repairs, in addition to visiting sites such as Pearl Harbor, etc.
Elder Lorren Godwin preached "Finding Jesus" from Job 23:3. Our world is a wreck. It has turned its back on God. The only answer for the world is to turn back to Jesus. There will never really be any problems solved without Him. Many go to psychologists, lawyers, and great doctors for answers to problems in their life but Jesus is the only answer to problems that really matter. Many times in our own lives we get bogged down with problems. All we have to do is find Jesus. Sometimes we have to encourage ourselves as David did. We need to get lost in God's presence, and let Him work out our problems.

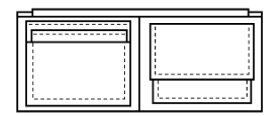

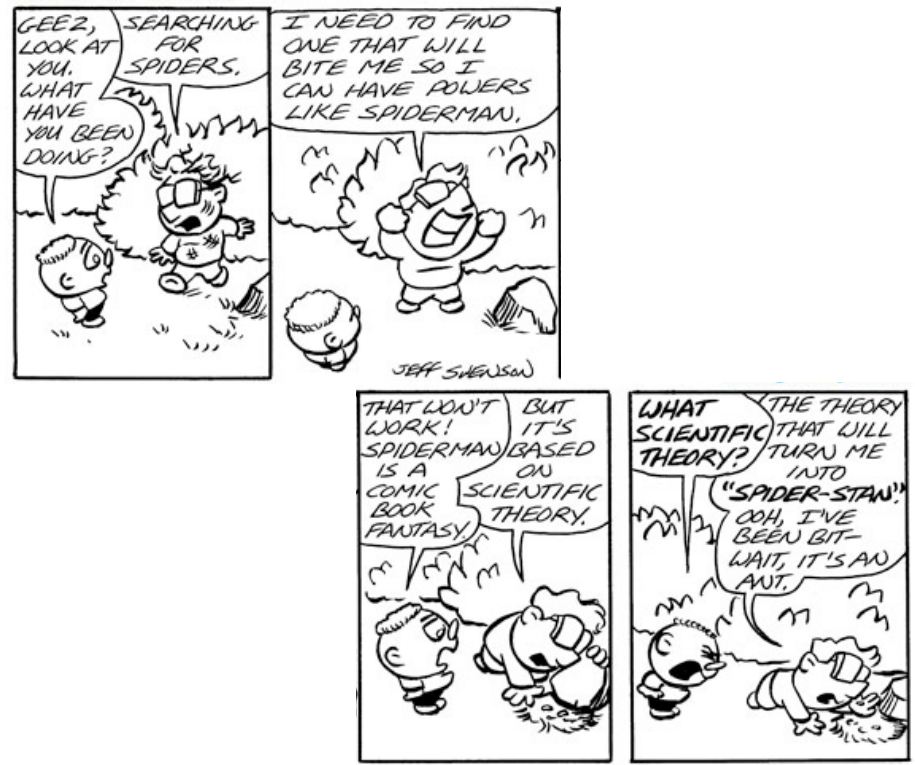

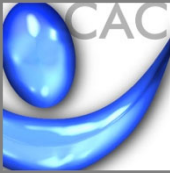
