Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph continued our ongoing series on the Ten Commandments, this time studying the Sabbath, in a lesson titled "Juxtaposed" from Exodus 20:8-11. God has often delighted in juxtaposing things that are quite different from each other. The Sabbath is holy (set apart from other days) and thus it is juxtaposed against the other days. God made the entire cosmos in six days and rested on the seventh day. God rested not because of weariness—He never gets tired. He simply worked until the task was complete and rested. His rest is an example for mankind (as we do grow weary) and it also foreshadowed our "rest" of trusting Him for our salvation by faith through the regeneration of His Spirit. We cannot earn salvation through our own works. The basic concept of holiness is to be separated from the common (or unclean) so as to be dedicated unto a special purpose. We must be set apart from the world. God also juxtaposed Peter and Paul. These two early Apostles were different in many ways. Just because God is doing things differently for you than He has done for others is not necessarily cause for alarm. Trust in Him!

Rev. Everett Davenport preached "Let Go Of Your Ego." The ego of man is defined as the consciousness of one's own existence. We must let go of the carnal aspects of our ego. The position of your soul determines the outcome of your life. You are either right or wrong; bound for either heaven or hell. God gave us the fivefold ministry to edify us and prepare us for the work of the Lord. He gave us the choice to receive or reject Him and His truth. Let go of your carnal ego and make right decisions. When we are submitted, E.G.O. can stand for "Exalting God Only." We are designed for His purposes. Instead of being self-centered, we need we ought to be Christ-centered. God wants us to work through His plan for His glory. We need to have a fear of displeasing God. We are to live a holy life. "Be ye holy; for I am holy" (I Peter 1-16). We must have the mind of Christ. Then we won't be thinking deceitfully and wickedly. We can be the hands and feet of the Lord, everywhere we go—if we let go of our ego.

Wednesday

Elder JT Sandy preached "Standing In The Hall Of Fame" from John 14:2-3 & Revelation 21:18-23. The Hall of Fame only accepts the best: players who have given their entire life to the game. We must live wholly for God; 80% won't do. "Set your affection on things above, not on things of the earth" (Colossian 3:2). We must have the mind of Christ. We must die daily. We can only enter into Heaven if we give our entire life to God. Always be ready!
Elder Baron Claypool preached "The Power Of Illogical Decisions" from II Kings 4:32-35. The Shunammite woman held onto the promise of God and sent for Elisha to come when her son died. We can't look only at our situation. We have to look to God. Think outside the box and know what God can do. Don't listen to your heart saying it can't be done. Think *illogically* and put your trust in God!

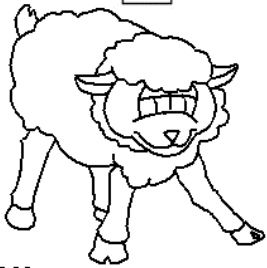
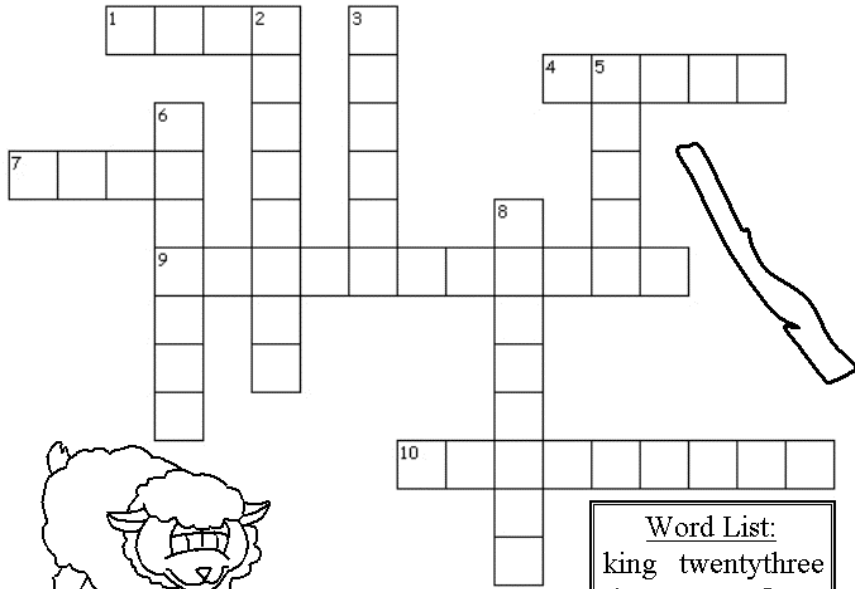
