Elder Lorren Godwin preached "The Foundation of a Relationship With God" from Deuteronomy 6:4-5, Matthew 6:33 & Acts 2:38. Jesus Christ gave His life for us. An ancient man, named Job, was the wealthiest man in the near east, but within a short span of time he lost his children, livestock, and home—all he possessed. Then he was smitten with boils. Elder Baron Claypool preached "Launch Out" from Luke 5:1-4. The Spirit of God is calling us to *launch out*. We will never reach what God has for us if we never take a leap of faith. Anyone can serve and praise God in shallows, a place where the storms of life can't reach us. Some are afraid to get into a deeper relationship with God, but we can't stay in shallow water. Though we fear storms that make the waters rise, if we're in the Lord's service, we're in His care. Life will be dangerous, but we must launch out deeper with God. The deeper our relationship with God, the more trials we'll have and the more we will suffer. You can't hold onto things in a storm. We need to get rid of bad attitudes and habits. Get rid of the cares of this life. We must not have a shallow relationship with God. "O Lord. How great are thy works! and thy thoughts are very deep" (Psalms 92:5).

### Wednesday

Elder Zach Sandy preached "This Is Not The End" from John 11:1-15. We don't see things as God sees them. They told Jesus that Lazarus was dead. "If He had been here, Lazarus would not have died." 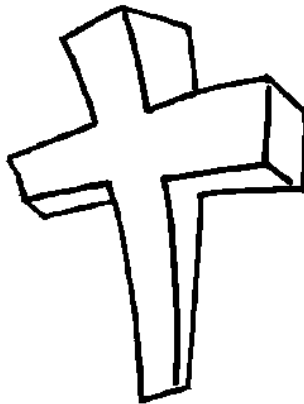
