Sunday AM

Pastor Joseph continued our Survey of the Book of Acts. Part #2 covered Acts 1:12-26, and we also previewed Acts 2:1-23. God robed Himself in flesh as a man, Jesus, to be a perfect sacrifice for the sins of mankind. Between the Old Covenant and the New Covenant, two crucial events happened for the apostles: (1) the Lord opened their understanding, and (2) He poured His Spirit upon them. At first they couldn't comprehend the foretold death, burial, and resurrection of the Messiah, Jesus. After the Messiah's crucifixion, the risen Lord appeared to the Apostles at various times, the last just days before He ascended to Heaven. The resurrected, glorified Jesus ate with the apostles. "Then opened he their understanding, that they might believe the scriptures" (Luke 24:45). He left the apostles over the Church, and commissioned them to preach the gospel. They obediently went to Jerusalem and were baptized with the Holy Ghost. Because the Lord chose, trained, illuminated, and filled them, it's crucial we pay attention to their actions/deeds, sermons, teachings & writings. We ought not view their doctrine as primitive, incomplete, or immature. We are to "earnestly contend for the faith which was once delivered unto the saints" (Jude 1:3). "Apostle" means "Sent" (i.e. Sent One). Jesus is the Chief Apostle. The Lord chooses and sends additional apostles. It behooves us to take heed unto their words.

Sunday PM

Sis. Jenni Claypool spoke on "Love Like Him" from I Corinthians 12:25-26 & Colossians 3:12-14. God wants us to show love to each other. There should be no divisions among us. We ought to get to know each other better.

Pastor Joseph preached Part #3 of the Survey of the Book of Acts, titled "What's Your Name?" from Acts 3:1-16 & 4:5-12. There is power in the name of Jesus, which literally means "YHWH-Salvation," i.e. "Yahweh (I AM) Savior." Jesus is God manifest in flesh. Jesus said, "I and my Father are one" (John 10:30). He told Philip, "He that hath seen me hath seen the Father" (John 14:9). God has revealed this truth to mankind. Peter, the Apostle, spoke by revelation, saying to Jesus "Thou art the Christ [i.e. Messiah], the Son of the living God" (Matthew 16:15-16). There is power in the name of Jesus. The lame man (Acts 3) was healed when the apostles prayed in Jesus name. Today people are healed, devils are cast out, and the dead are raised in Jesus name. We must take on the Lord's name in water baptism, and do all in Jesus name. According to Lord in the Book of Revelation, all who overcome will get a new name, but also get the Lord's new name on them.

Elder Brian Murphy preached "Look On Him" from Numbers 21:9. The enslaved Israelites needed both a deliverer and a revelation of who God is. They had to completely trust Moses to guide them. If people are following you, where are you leading them? People are watching! You must live like Jesus did. You must tell your family and friends about Jesus. Follow the guidance of your elders and pastor. Lift up the name of Jesus. Walk in the footsteps of Jesus. Revival is here!
